1. Top left: Luggage and stores about to leave Kalimpong.
2. Bottom left: Leaving Gangtok, 31 October 1933, 8:30 a.m.
3. Bottom right: Going through Penlong Pass.

#### LEAF 2 (verso)

1. Top left: Between Mangan and Singhik.
2. Center left: Sunrise on snows at Singhik
3. Top right: From Singhik Bungalow.
4. Bottom right: Early morning.

#### LEAF 3 (recto)

1. Top left: Near Joong Bridge, 3 November 1933.
2. Top right: Ready for the mules at Joong, 3 November 1933, 8:30 a.m.
3. Bottom left: Waterfall near Joong (upper part).

1. Top left: A pack mule on a land-slide, 31 November 1933.

1. Top left: After Sunday school at Lachung.
2. Top right: Sunday school gathering again.
3. Bottom right: Tea in the Mission garden after church service, 5 November 1933.

#### LEAF 7 (recto)

1. Top center: View from Mission House verandah after Sunday school, 5 November 1933.
2. Bottom left: After church, Sunday, 12 November 1933.
3. Bottom right: After Sunday school, 12 November 1933.

#### LEAF 8 (verso)

1. Top center: With some children at Lachung.
2. Bottom left: Playing by the way.
3. Bottom right: A glimpse of Miss Sparrow on the road.

#### LEAF 9 (recto)

1. Top left: Misses Sparrow, Wood, Whalen (sic) and Pollock about to leave Lachung for Yumthang.
2. Top right: About to cross a land-slide on the way to Yumthang.
3. Bottom left: Another view on the way to Yumthang.
4. Bottom right: The plateau and snowy heights near Yumthang.

2. Top right: Return to Lachen, near Thangu, taken while snow was falling, 14 November 1933, 8:30 a.m.
3. Bottom center: A glimpse of a river bed!

1. Top left: Tibetan encampment near Chumthang, 15 November 1933.
2. Top right: Snowy heights and a gorge near Chumthang.
3. Bottom left: Climbing the land-slide near Chumthang, narrow path with large drop to river depths on one side.
4. Bottom right: Above the land-slide. Rocky, overshadowing heights about, rumbling depths many feet below.

1. Top left and right: Returning to Gangtok. Last day on our mules. Just had lunch, 18 November 1933.
2. Bottom center: Gangtok Bazaar, 19 November 1933.

1. Top left: Royal Pavilion on Palace grounds. Picture of actors in Tibetan play. Maharajah on steps — had only seen! We are inside the curtains.
2. Bottom right: Tibetan play and pavilion.
