The alumni activities of the West China Union University

The alumni of the West China Union University can be visualized from different angles. A perspective of their activities may be obtained from the following summary.

1. What is the total member - There are 1384 in all from 1915 up to 1945. There were only two in the first class (1915) and 161 in the latest class (1945). You can imagine the rapid growth of their alma mater in these thirty years from this figure. (see table I)
2. Where do they come from - It is of great interest to notice that even though their alma mater is located in West China, the alumni, incidentally come from the 18 different provinces in China, and a few from abroad, such as Java, Korea, Hungary, Russia and the United States of America. (see table II) The source of the alumni is national and international. Obviously, the geographical distance from sea coast can neither disturb the growth of their alma mater nor prevent the students from coming to Chengtu from other provinces and even from other parts of the world.
3. Where are they - It may be true that the alumni of West China Union University who have been abroad are not as many as any other Christian Universities in China. They are mostly distributed in the interior of China where their service is needed most and where very few educated people are willing to go; this was true before the war. (see table III)
4. What are their contributions - It is true that there are not many "big shots", among the alumni of the W.C.U.U., so far especially in the political field. Notwithstanding the main objective and aim of the university education is not merely to produce a few outstanding persons, but to provide graduates to meet the needs of the masses. We should be proud of our alumni for their direct service with the local community. We know "Roast chicken" is more delicious than "Fried potato". But potato is much more in demand. The alumni of West China may be as if "small potato", not a main course in the menu, but it can satisfy the people's need.

Chu Hwan Chang came to West China from Miao tribe. After his completion of his education in the university, he went back to serve his fellow brothers. He introduced modern cultures into his tribe. He is regarded as the "Confucius" of his tribe.

Wu Hsin Shen a medical graduate of the West China. He also came from that Miao tribe. He is regarded as the "Pasteur" of his tribe brothers.

Cheng Shi Chun was a very poor boy when he had his mechanical training in the West China Union University. But now he has made a wonderful fortune by his own effort and outstanding ability in engineering. He recently donated a Building to the University which is worth about fifty millions.

Although the average alumni are not very well to do, however, in 1943, they raised an amount of one million dollars for the celebration of the thirty fifth anniversary of their alma mater. The alumni of agriculture, home economics as well as dental alumni also contributed a great amount of money to their mother colleges.

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There were 97 alumni, from medicine, dentistry, pharmacy who joined the army service and 56 from other departments joined the military service, and served as interpreters or youth soldiers.

Quite a few of our alumni who are holding governmental positions in political field as well as in cultural and health service.

The dental alumni are finding employment all over China. The members who carry on the National Dental Health Program are all from West China Dental School. It is recognized that this school is the cradle of dental personnel in China and the alumni must assume responsibility for meeting the wide demand for leaders of dental education as well as public oral health.

During my first trip to the Border of Tibet, I rode a horse to climb a mountain which was about 17000 feet high. My horse climbed up ceaselessly from early morning till noon. I was so disappointed when I looked up wards because there was still a long distance to the peak. However, it was amazing to look back to the foot of the mountain, because I had advanced a tremendous distance, which I could hardly believe.

It is sincerely hoped that we alumni as well as our friends, when we evaluate our alma mater or the activities of our alumni, better not stand on the peak but stand at the foot of the mountain to appreciate how far we have advanced. This may be the best way of encouragement to push the progress and development of the West China Union University as well as the effort of the alumni.

These make a total of 1262 living ones.

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Since the war broke on July 7th, 1937, the invasion proceeded from North China onward to Central China and South China. The Chinese people being aware of the loss of territory and possible extinction of the race, undertook the defensive war against the enemy. For eight years, young and old all over the whole country either fought in the front or supported the soldiers, at the rear. In spite of financial difficulties due to the inflation and disturbances by air raids our University opened as usual and in addition took many refugee students at the request of the Government and accommodated several guest institutions on our campus. Moreover we took active part in all kinds of war time services and encouraged our students to join the army or to do first aid work at the front or to help improving communication services. Although none of them did anything particularly great they have done their duty as good citizens. The following is an outline of various war time organizations in our University and students joining different service corps.

1. Defense Supporting Society of the Rear Areas. The enemy began to invade our country and Lu-hou-chiao was captured on July 7th, 1937 after which fighting continued along the coast and the Huata Defense Supporting Society was organized in our University to contribute to war-time services.

2. Air Raid Service. The enemy intended to gain a quick end of the fighting and bombed our rear areas terribly. The Air Raid Service Corp was organized which in cooperation with the police directed the people to evacuate from the city before the actual raids and helped the wounded and extinguished fires after the raids. A girl student, Hwang Hsiao lien sacrificed her life in rescuing some wounded during one of the raids.

3. Other services.

- (1) Contribution to the Government and to soldiers at the front.
- (2) Sending winter clothing to soldiers.
- (3) Visiting and sending gifts to families of soldiers.
- (4) House to house investigation to prevent incoming of spies.

4. Service during vacations.

- (1) Defensive war propaganda. This was done in the summer and winter vacations either by individuals or by organized groups and sometimes they used plays to attract audiences.
- (2) Conscription propaganda. This was also done in the vacations.

5. Province of Honan Medical Service Corp. At the time of the famine of Honan a medical service corp was organized which travelled through Shanshi and Honan helping the people in their diseases and suffering. This was much appreciated by both the Government and the people.

6. Rescue of War Orphans. When the war came to the provinces of Hunan and Kwangshi there were a great number of war orphans in those provinces. A War Orphans Rescue Corp was organized and more than one hundred students joined it voluntarily. Due to transportation difficulties they were unable to carry out their purposes.

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7. Volunteers in response to the Generalissimo's appeal.
- (1) 27 enlisted in the educated youth army.
 - (2) 30 enlisted and flew to India to join the army there.
 - (3) 1 joined the navy.
 - (4) 25 joined the air force.
 - (5) 7 joined the air transportation service.
 - (6) 41 medical students joined medical services.
 - (7) 9 dental students joined dental services.
 - (8) 21 pharmacy students joined pharmaceutical services.
 - (9) 10 went as translators for the American Army.

On Nov. 4th, 1941, at about 5 A.M. a single enemy plane appeared over Changteh, West Hunan province of China. Instead of bombs, wheat and rice grains, pieces of paper, cotton wadding and some unidentified particles were dropped. Suspicion that the enemy had scattered plague-infective material was in the mind of the medical workers who saw the incident on the spot.

Seven days after the "aerial incident" when the first suspicious case of plague came to notice. The sixth case was proved by me to be genuine bubonic plague by post-mortem findings, confirmed by culture and animal tests; when I had just arrived from Kwei-yang with an investigation unit.

I had the honour of submitting the "Report on plague in Changteh, Hunan" to our National Health Authorities, with the following conclusions:-

1. That plague was epidemic in Changteh from Nov. 11th to 24th, 1941.

2. That the cause of the epidemic was due to the scattering of plague infective material, probably infective fleas, by an enemy plane on Nov. 4th, 1941.

Fortunately nothing happened to me.

My furniture and many medical books and other Chinese literature which were kept in my friend's house were destroyed by Japanese bombing while I was a postgraduate student in America.

Now, the war is over, but the conditions are worse than former years. Because the civil war is still going on, and the people could not live well under such a bad condition. How shall the Christianity do to save China into bright and peace age from the dark and sad time?

It would be worth while to mention that I have attended the work of medical relieve organization operating from June to Oct. 1943 in Honan Province. I was taking the leadership of the first branch working chiefly in Laoyang governing two whole-day clinics and assisted in the Catholic Hospital. Honan was at that time flooded by Yellow and was overcrowded with refugees. Our work was concerned only for refugees all our medicinals were donated from the International Relieve Comm. We have two teams of medical students and doctors, some of them were graduated 6 yrs. One team worked in Tsengchaw, on the way of Peiping-Hankao rail way and the real front of the Sino-japanese War. We were credited by over 30,000 patients that may die ^{without our help} with many acute infectious diseases.

May I report one thing that I have made me so interested. It was the discovery of a new disease new to my community medical work^{er} in Chungking. ----a special type of ascariis worm disease ,in which the worm is impacting in the common bile duct of human subject causing very vio-lent abdominal pain. I have learned some the news from Chengtu, although very occasionally encountered. but it was by all means strange to Chungking people and because this was not quoted in the text books. Intestinal ascariasis (dewelling of the worms in intestines) is of course a common illness among Chinese and this special type seems gradually tome a common rather than curious one. I am working this item as really a public health problem because I have ^{seen} encountered this acute disease four times in the past year.

I was arrested by Japanese police in 1939 January in Tientsin, because I came from Szechuan and they thought of me as a spy for Chinese. After keeping me for 9 1/2 days they let me out, because my missionary friends American and British of Cheelo University tried to find me out through American Consulate and Japanese consulate. Japanese tried to force me to work for them as a spy among missionaries in Cheelo University, but they did not succeed in it. As America was not yet in war with Japan at that time my American friends could greatly help me out. Dr. R. T. Shields of Presbyterian mission was at that time in Tsinan and he could confirm my story. When all American and British, Canadian members of Cheelo University were kept in Tsinan under guard of Japanese after declaration of war, before they were sent home or interned, I was treated the same way as they were by Japanese, although I am a Russian Emigrant. I had a hard time to get away to Tsingtao and many very unpleasant days before I got away from Tsinan.

Thanks to God it is all over.

On the day of Aug. 20, 1943, we were operated on a appendicitis patient. When the operation was going on, the Japanese bombers came. Then we carried our patient into a stone cave. Just in the mid-way (about half mile from the operation room to the cave) the Japanese bombers throw three bombs which were only very closed to us. Very fortunately, we were all unwounded. Only a nurse lost her hearing of both ears for about four months.

On the day of Sept 30, 1944 at 3 p.m. the Japanese bombers came to us. (We were worked in the Red Cross Hospital of Chungking.) We had about 100 patients and 30 nurses hid ourselves in a big earth cave. One bomb just throw on the top of our cave. The damage was so much and terrible that our lamps were broken off. So the cave was suddenly dark. We thought we would lose our lives now. After 10 minutes, we came out from that cave and found no one was wounded. But 2 nurses and 7 patients lost their hearing for a long time. Our faces and bodies were covered with earth and dust when we came out from the cave. So we could not recognize each other.

After that I went to Laming which is a place in the West part of Yunnan province. I worked in the Central air craft manufacturing Company's hospital about 9 years. After the Japanese destroyed the factory in 1942. Then I came back again and took responsibility in Prost. dept. of dental clinic of West China union university.*

37. PLEASE TELL BRIEFLY ABOUT ANY UNUSUAL EXPERIENCES YOU HAVE HAD. FOR EXAMPLE, WERE YOU INTERNED, CAPTURED, BOMBED, ETC? *When I was in Laming which is a small place near Burma, I was working in Central aircraft manufacturing Company's hospital giving dental service to the factory's members & their families. One day at noon time I had just finished my lunch. When suddenly there was an air alarm. I ran quickly out & saw many Japanese aeroplanes already flying above the factory & bombing very heavily. We couldn't run far from my house so I laid down at once to the hospital staff. If our houses had been bombed at that time all of us would ~~have~~ been finished together. Fortunately none of us were injured, although so many small pieces of bombshells flew about. Some houses & aeroplanes of our factory were burned & some damaged. When the Jap. planes were gone we went to the hospital within a few minutes. All the place was filled with wounded people shouting & crying very pitifully. We helped to give them treatment, bandages, injection etc. Everyone was busy the whole day and night. The worst thing was no electric light & running water because they were damaged by the bombing. So the foreigners of our factory took water from the river in big containers and brought it to the hospital by car. Otherwise we couldn't wash our dirty bloody hands. The factory members were all busy some put out the fire & some hurried to dig out the earth from the dugout, because many people had been covered in it. especially women & children. In this time many people died & many were wounded. This was the 1st time the factory was bombed. It had to stop ^{its} work & was closed for several months.*

I always think and thought that the life is very wonderful if a person got the long experience from whom he had happened. I am quite doubtful that the individual fate influences the life which surrounds him, but in fact sometimes it is unthinkable that the fate, even the death of the individual, seems so definite, fixed in the cycle of existence to the end of breath. I have been narrowly escaped for my life from the bomb during the war several times. I also saw the very tragedy that many people have been happened to end the life within the single minute. Even if we were in a same space, sometimes I escaped, but other people just met the right hit. We have been accustomed for bombing during the war, certainly it is no surprise for a death will come in a single minute.

Once at time at fire, my office was near burned, I tried to get out of some articles from my office, even though the fire is so danger to us, but I wanted to get out some more articles from the office, the more better for keeping along with my affairs. Until the fire burned to my neighboring room, I went away from the office. As soon as as I stepped out the door of my office, the wall was overthrew the door of my office and uneasy blowing sounds stroke me and made me a backturn to see what has happened. Suddenly I fell into very nervous that I found out my life has been in danger just one minute before.

Life gives me a wonderful history. I always think and thought that nothing can be happened or will be happend and everything can be happened and will be happened within the destiny of capacity from which only "God makes well when and where for a person bears and dies". Do you believe it or not.
