## Syracuse-in-China Nominates Tom Scott As Overseas Rep; Gertner, Pray Elected

Thomas Scott, a graduate student in the Syracuse University College of Law, will be the Syracuse representative to West China Union University, replacing Don Flaherty, the present representative.

A graduate of Syracuse University, Scott was president of Kappa Sigma fraternity, a member of Westminster fellowship and Chapel interfaith. During the war, he served in the infantry and was an instructor in the U. S. Military Academy at West Point.

### Two-Year Stay

He will go to China in August for a period of two years to teach English to medical students and freshmen in the College of Arts and Science and to lecture in the college lecture program at West China Union University. He has now been enrolled in the course, teaching English to foreign students at Columbia University.

Flaherty will receive a fellowship in the Maxwell School of Citizenship upon returning to Syracuse university in the fall. He will take an active leadership in helping to further the Syracuse-in-China organization.

The representative is sent with funds raised on campus as student representative to the staff of West China Union University.

By presenting speakers and holding discussions groups, Syracuse-in-China has tried to broaden the interest and knowl-

edge of the problems of China.

The first program in March consisted of five reports about the conference held at Syracuse in the end of February. These reports were made by five students who attended.

On the agenda for March, was the celebration of 'Don Flaherty Day.' On this day, the organization showed slides and read letters from the representative in West China Union University.

During March, Syracuse-in-China also had as speakers Prof. J. Alexander Romig of the business law department, who was born in Shantung, China, and Prof. Douglas Haring, of the Anthropology department whose field of specialization is the Far East. They spoke on "What should we do about China?" a program dealing with American policy in China.

### Chinese Customs

Customs of China were dealt with in a series of meetings. Frank Yeh spoke about Chinese weddings, and costumes of the time of the empire and after the revolution were modeled by Betty Ruth Scott, Vi Todoki, and Beverly Chan. At the second meeting, Mr. Kin-Ne-Tong, graduate student and instructor in engineering, spoke on Chinese festivals. Also at this meeting, Marty Pray, new co-president of Syracuse-in-China, gave a short report on his trip to Oberlin for Oberlin-in-Shansi day. Rita Gertner was also elected as president for next year.

Daniel S. Dye of Marietta, Ohio, when he arrived in China in 1910 as a young graduate of Denison University, took three months to travel from Shanghai to Chengtu, in Szechuan, journeying by river steamer up the Yangtze to Chungking, and from there by road to Chengtu. Dye was one of a handful of young men, just out of college, with a year or two of teaching experience or postgraduate work, who had been brought together as the staff of the just organized West China Union University.

"We dug up fewer than twenty students," he recalls, "and everybody studied everything." That was the beginning of the University which now covers 148 English acres, has 5000 students in its various schools and subsidiary units, and is one of the thirteen Christian Colleges in China; a University famous now for its pioneering Dental School, the first in China; its outstanding Medical School; its experiments in scientific farming and rural education; its Museum known throught the world for its collection of West China antiquities.

Dr. Dye, a tall, spare man with brown eyes continually twinkling, told me that West China Union University -- Hua Hsi Ba for short -- owed its existence to the Empress Dowager. What he meant was that just at the time when five mission boards were getting together to form a union university in Chengtu, the Empress Dowager did away with the old imperial system which made aknowledge of the classics the basis of a higher education, and gave her blessing to the western system.

It was just the impetus which was needed to bring students flocking to Hua Hsi Ba. Government schools, founded in response to the Empress Dowager's edict, looked to the missionary school for leadership. Dr. Dye, who headed the University's department of science, set exams in the early days for schools all over the province, and personally read all the examination papers.

Dr. Dye returns to Marietta next year, his long service to West China ended. Many of those whom Dr. Dye likes to call the "founding fathers" have preceded him in retirement. To maintain the high standards which they set is not going to be easy, he points out, in the difficult period just ahead.

In the first academic year after the war, West China Union had its own particular rehabilitation problem. Unlike most other institutions of higher learning in China, it had not been forced to evacuate its campus during the war. On the other hand, being located in the heart of Free China, it became host to four refugee universities -- Nanking, Ginling, Yenching, and Cheeloo.

When these universities moved out to return to their own campuses, West China Union had a tremendous reconstruction job on its hands. Partitions built to create classrooms and offices for the guest universities had to be ripped out to restore rooms to their original uses. Long over-due repairs to roofs, floors, walls, furniture and equipment had to be made. Dormitories which had suffered from over-crowding had to be renovated. Unlike other universities, West China University could not claim a share of the rehabilitation funds granted by the Government to schools whose campuses had been occupied by the enemy, and it had to find funds for its rehabilitation where it could.

In early summer, 1947, to the eye of the casual visitor, the beautiful greystone buildings with graceful Chinese roofs -- a happy blend of East and West -- appeared to be fully restored, although workmen were busy on various parts of the campus with small jobs, such as painting. Then unprecedented rains brought a devastating flood which swept into basements, flattened compound walls, washed away roads. Under the downpour, roofs sprang leaks and water seeped in to damage ceilings and walls. Chinese mud and brick stoves disintegrated. A hundred yards of stone embankment on the river front was undermined and parts of it washed away. University authorities estimated that at least \$5000, American currency, would be needed to make repairs on the campus. Rebuilding of the river embankment would take \$5000 more.

The flood disaster is one more problem added to many. A by-product of the War years was a greatly increased enrollment, which must be cut down to maintain teaching standards. At present, laboratories are greatly overcrowded, students having to share tables and equipment, such as microscopes. Since microscopes must be shared, no one student can be held accountable for damages to his instrument, so each microscope is carefully examined after every using by laboratory assistants, and locked up between laboratory periods. Similar watchful care is given to every type of equipment.

These are minor difficulties compared to the problem of maintaining teaching personnel. The war brought the world to Chengtu's door; with the war over, the old city has returned to its former isolation. Dr. Dye, when he returns to America, can, if he likes, take a plane that will bring him to Chungking in less than an hour; from Chungking, it is a 7-hour plane journey to Shanghai. But plane journeys are too expensive for the average traveler. Now, as in the old days, Chengtu's main link with coastal cities is by river or by road. It is no accident that the expression, "down river people" lingers in the speech of Chengtu; a derogatory phrase which indicates the native provincialism.

In addition to some of its own brilliant graduates, distinguished graduates from other universities have been lured to Chengtu by the prestige of some of its schools and departments.

One of Dr. Dye's own special fields of interest -- the University Museum -- is a case in point. In 1914, Dr. Dye, fascinated by the rich lore of West China antiquity, asked the University for permission to start the collection of historical relics for a museum. He carried on the task until 1931, when it was taken over by David Crockett Graham.

Dr. Dye, having seen the University survive one trying period after another, looks upon the present period as neither the best of times nor the worst of times. And the future is a challenge. West China serves an area of 100,000,000 population -- an area that needs teachers, doctors, nurses, scientific farmers, welfare workers of all kinds.

The increasing number of students from Szechuan is a healthy factor. They are likely, after graduation, to remain in their native province, putting to use the skills they have acquired in Chengtu among their own people. West China will continue to attract, Dr. Dye is sure, a certain proportion of earnest students from other provinces to major in the specialized subjects which have made the university famous.

Thirty-seven years ago, Dr. Dye tells you, he came to Chengtu as a young missionary with as much to learn as he had to teach. He learned much; his colleagues say that there are few people in the world who know as much about West China antiquities, its fascinating history, the lore of the countryside, as Dr. Dye does. More important, he takes back to America a great faith in the Chinese people, a faith that has grown during the years, as he has seen China pull through one crisis after another. China needs help and understanding at this time, he says, but more than anything else, China needs leadership -- the kind which West China Union has for many years been developing.
