36. WHERE WERE YOU AND WHAT DID YOU DO DURING THE WAR? I was in Chengtu most of the time. Besides attending to the sick, I taught in four universities and was also helping out in government institutions, military as well as civil. I made surveys of the eye condition of a number of cities and towns in Szechuan. One expedition was made into a district of the tribesmen. Studies were also conducted in different blind institutions, including one for blinded soldiers. I am particularly proud of my medical service during air raids.
37. PLEASE TELL BRIEFLY ABOUT ANY UNUSUAL EXPERIENCES YOU HAVE HAD. FOR EXAMPLE, WERE YOU INTERNED, CAPTURED, BOMBED, ETC? In 1937 I traveled from Szechuan down to Hongkong on the newly opened highways in order to get medical supplies for our hospital. On my way back, I was in an automobile accident whereby my left thigh was dislocated. Even now I cannot hike any long distance. My adventure down south China cannot be described in a few lines. In 1937 before I came to this province, I went thru several air raids in and near Tsinan and Shanghai. One of the most dangerous occasions was when a big bomb fell about 20 yds. from me killing more than 1000 people. The car in which I was to ride home was burned beyond recognition; so was our driver. In cities and on highways I was strafed by machinegun bullets from enemy planes. In Feb. 1940 Chengtu E.E.N.T. Hospital was attacked. Some bullets fell only a couple of feet from me. Another most thrilling moment in my life was when 108 Jap planes bombed our hospital. It was a fine day when the air alarm went off on on July 27, 1941. As usual, I remained in our hospital to give moral support to our critically ill patients and to be ready to administer to the air raid victims. My wife decided to stay behind with me. We were married a little over a year ago & had a baby of barely 4 months old. I solicited my wife to carry our tiny child into the shelter closeby our house which is located in in the hospital compound. I was watching the planes as they glided towards us. The explosion of bombs in other parts of the city forcefully warned me to rush into the shelter too. I did. Immediately a bomb landed behind our house and wrecked our kitchen. In another 2 or 3 seconds, one fell four feet short of our living room. Glass splinters, plaster and metallic particles flew inside & outside of our house. Luckily the second bomb was only a dud which drilled deeply into our yard until water was seen. The planes disappeared. The excitement was, however, not over. We opened the gate of our hospital. Soon hundreds of wounded were brought in ^{for} emergency care. The stories of my patients were definitely more painful and ~~exciting~~ ^{exciting} than mine.

There was an air raid on June 11 '1939, in Chengde, during that raid I evacuated to the country about 3 miles from West China University. After it was cleared out, before I returned our university, I heard ^{that} southern part of Chengde was bombed and lots of people died and wounded, so I rushed to do first aid. After that I returned my room which was next to the Baptist Middle School dormitory, and found it was crushed, as my ~~total~~ neighbour dormitory was ~~turned~~ bombed, so I was homeless for two months.

Once upon a time, when I was not far from the city, more than one hundred
Japanese heavy bombers came. When they were above us, bombs made the
thrill and explosion from far to my direction. Every body can imagine
how does it make one's mind under tension. The last bomb dropped was
less than 100 yards from^{me}. I was not injured but dust covering my
whole body, as I was unhidden by anything. I was in danger.
(2) Hungery is a normal physiological desire. When in extreme, one
piece of peanut will mean a lot. One day after a simple breakfast on
the Er-Mei Mountain, a famous and beautiful place, with one of my friends,
we planned to have a nice lunch at the next station, temple. In the
afternoon we arrived there, but we were refused to be admitted for some
reasons. So we had to continue our travel with empty stomach. We
were in very hard time. Two hours later we could hardly climb any more
and there was no body on or near the path. The abdomen gave continuous
gurgling sound. We sat down to have little rest. Unexpectedly, I
discovered few pieces of peanuts in my pocket. We were immediately
greatly delighted and strengthened by means of the scanty amount of
intake. We enjoyed it. I learned what did "hungery" mean.

all along the way — starvation, long faces etc.
But the most impressive & dangerous part was the
passing through the border between occupied and
free China.

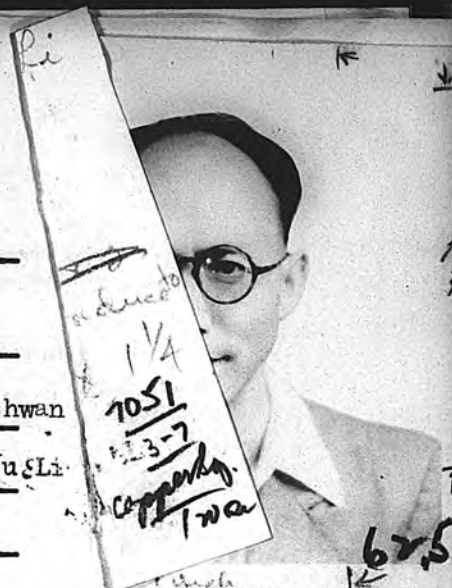

were taken care of by the First Aid Teams of Chengtu trained and organized since 1937.
During this raid one of the first aiders on the campus was killed and two injured.

These teams continued to work till the end of the War.
