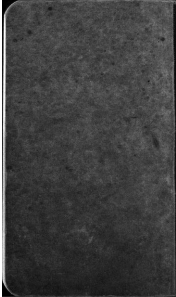

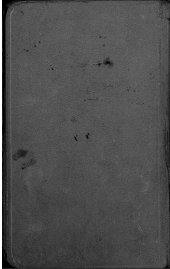

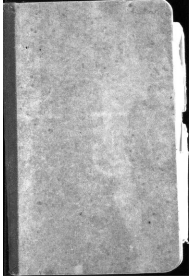

A line is a geometrical concept having but one dimension length. - A line is without surface, distance, and also direction. - A line can be of any length. A line is a subset of surface.

A straight line is one all the parts of which go in one direction.

A curved line is one that changes its direction continually.

A point is a thought used to indicate position.

A point is not tangible. A point is that which has position only.

A surface is something which has length and breadth.

A plane surface is that upon which a straight line may be placed in any direction.

A curved surface is one upon which two straight lines cannot be constructed in different directions.

2. A plane surface is one upon which a straight line joining any two points may be drawn. In a curved surface is one upon which two lines cannot be constructed at angles.

An angle is the divergence of two lines from a common point.

When two angles form the sides of two angles they are said to be adjacent.

Perpendicular lines are those which form equal adjacent angles.

Adjacent angles, whose sum will give two right angles are said to be supplementary.

Parallel lines extend in the same direction and the same distance apart and will never meet.

Adjacent angles have the same vertex and a common side.

Vertical angles are those in which the sides of one angle extend in the opposite direction through a common vertex and form two sides of the other vertex.

Corollary is a subordinate theorem.
