

SUMMARY OF THE BACCALAUREATE SERMON Rev. 21;5 Behold, I make all things new

In one of his little books Henry Van Dyke refers to three ideals in education: the decorative, the marketable, and the creative. man with the first, thinks of education as an ornamental appendage to his own life, a thing that will give him an air of distinction and a reputation for being refined and polished. The second man wants an education, not for the purpose of living, but for the purpose of making a living or accumulating wealth - wealth for its own sake or as an instrument of pleasure or power, a means for the gratification of ambition and pride. If any of you should stop on either of those two rounds of the ladder, you have missed the highest thing in life and your professors here as well as your friends would be ashamed of The only adequate ideal in education is the creative ideal. The man with this ideal is the one who is able to make things new. He is able to create music out of sound, poetry out of words, beauty out of colors, and form out of matter. He is filed with the spirit of the Creator, who says, "Behold, I make all things new."

The man with the creative ideal has found a new life; he is a new man himself. A new life makes all things new. The uninteresting life of the Russian peasants has acquired an inexplicable charm in the pages of Tolstoi. Christ fires the soul with the creative spirit. Life becomes a work of art. He says, "Behold I make all things new."

The man with the creative ideal has found a new truth. A new truth makes all things new. A new Christian world emerged when Luther saw a new truth; the condition in England changed when George Fox caught a vision of "The far land of Light". Christ opens a person's mind to perceive the great truth which would set him free. "Behold, I make all things new."

The man with the creative ideal has found a new way, a way of love. Love makes all things new. You remember how a little child stirred the hidden fountains of life in the miser's heart, and Silas Marner once devoid of friendships and affection found a new way and a new world. Old things passed way, and all things became new. When Jesus described and lived out in datail the ideal of man animated by great and enduring love of man, he pictured a potential power for everyone.

This is the way that Christ makes all things new. He says, "I am the Life the Truth, and the Way." He makes us new and all things new, not by any miraculous or supernatural power, but by giving us a new heart and a new spirit, by the power of the new truth which he shows to us, and the new love with which he inspires us. "If any man be in Christ he is a new creature." You may have been in this classes, in the chemistry or physics laboratory, but if you have not been in Jesus you have failed to secure that highest and noblest power that this university would give you, namely the power to make all things new, for "you can do all things through Christ which strengtheth you".
