

I was very happy to have seen you again in Detroit during the Thanksgiving season. We went further West for almost one more month. We came back to the East for Christmas. We are now holding our China Colleges Conferences in New York. We shall have several conferences in and around Boston next week, then we shall go to Syracuse and Rochester until the end of January. We appreciate very much the people who have come to those conferences, and also for their interest in our work. We hope that through these conferences, better understanding and more cooperation will be had from our American Christian friends for the work of Christian higher education in China.

I wish also to thank you for your check for \$10.00 which I have turned over to our Treasurer here, and it will be applied for our work at Fukien for the present year. It is certainly good of you to do what you have done. The Mission Boards have been cutting their appropriations to us during the last several years; in the meanwhile our work has been growing quite steadily, and the opportunities for service were never so great as they are at the present. We have, therefore, felt very keenly the financial difficulties. With the help coming from friends like yourself, we are much encouraged, for we do appreciate friends who show such great interest in the work that we are doing. You can be sure that your investment will bring the finest fruits for the Christian service in our country.

I shall be staying at 85 Sherman Street, Hartford, Connecticut for a large part of the Spring term. I shall be giving a series of lectures in the Seminary there. It is my hope that some time in the Spring I might come to Detroit again and that I may have the opportunity of another visit with you.
