

REPORT OF THE TREASURER

TRUSTEES OF FUKIEN CHRISTIAN UNIVERSITY

For the Year (11 Months) 1931-32

Agreeable to actions on the field and conforming thereto the Board of Trustees voted to change the fiscal year to begin July 1st and end June 30th. In making this adjustment only 11 months were considered as constituting a year for the 1931-32 period. (See T-981.)

Endowment Section

Endowment funds increased \$361.15 during the period in the following manner:-

Appreciation on sale of Japanese Bonds Excess income on E. C. Jones fund	\$ 350.00 53.26
Less overdraft July 1, 1931	\$403.26

The proceeds of the sale of Japanese Bonds were used to purchase 5,000 Pennsylvania 5% Bonds due in 1956 6 \$95. This left a cash balance of \$179.90.

Plant Section

The only change in Plant funds is the receipt of \$2,500.00 for residences, from the Glencoe Church.

This has been drawn by the field together with \$2,500.00 held as cash at the close of 1930-31, increasing the Residence debit account by \$5,000.00. Land, Plant, and Equipment now total \$351,091.76.

Current Section

The Budget analysis shows shrinkage in the payments of the appropriations of the Church Missionary Society and the Methodist Board. The Reformed and American Boards paid the amount originally inserted in the Budget. Serious decreases, however, were recorded in Harvard-Yenching Institute and Endowment income due largely to decrease in Aluminum dividend.

Doar Sirs:

I have the honor to present herewith the seventeenth annual report of the treasurer for the fiscal year (eleven months) ending June 30, 1932, in which is given the financial history of the university for the year and its condition at its close of the period.

Rev. H. V. Lacy was acting treasurer for the first two months; while the undersigned assumed the duties of the office for the remainder of the year.

ENDOWMENT FUNDS

The total amount of endowment funds of the University in the field on June 30, 1932 was \$4,187.43, an increase of \$800.39 during the year. This increase consists of the following:

Botany Endowment Scholarship \$145.71 \$654.68 \$300.79

SURPLUS

The current operations of the year resulted in a surplus of \$26,097.84 which has been carried to the Reserve Fund. This is mainly due to the following.*

Receipts in Excess of Estimates: Gain on Gold Exchange \$15,912.27, Student Fees. \$5.787.58.

Savings in Expenditure: Beeman's travel \$2,125.00, Budget economics \$2,272.99.

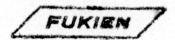

Fisher File 6 REPORT OF THE TREASURER BOARD OF TRUSTEES, FUKIEN CHRISTIAN UNIVERSITY FOR THE YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1945 Fukien Christian University continued to carry on its work at Shaowu although it suffered greatly from the loss of Foreign Staff and the ramifications of inflation. Communication with the University Administration was largely halted during the year and only a few cables and letters got through. Thus the constituency in the United States has not been as well informed as in the past. Money raising program in the United States was largely centered in the efforts of the Associated Boards, to secure sufficient relief funds from United China Relief to keep the work going in China. Later comments in this report will indicate that the local currency dollars secured probably cared for the 1944-45 needs. This Report is accompanied by the following papers:

ENDOWMENT

The total Endowment Funds increased by \$113.39 during the year to a new figure of \$168,787.04. This increase came entirely from income on the Endowment Income Stabilization Fund.

There was an increase of Mission Board support as shown in the Budget Analysis (Page 8). The American Board also paid \$1,115.00 for vacancies on staff. There was also an increase in Endowment Income. The decrease in Sustaining Funds was due to the larger rate of exchange secured through the operation of the United Clearing Board. The Local Currency equivalent of Sustaining Funds actually sent to China was L.C.\$12,541,175.92, a truly inflated amount in comparison to previous years. Due to the death of Mr. John G. Talcott no income was received during the year in the account carried in his name and expenses closed out the balance of \$1,489.30, carried forward on June 30, 1944.
