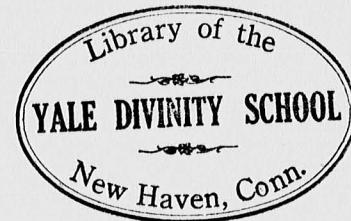

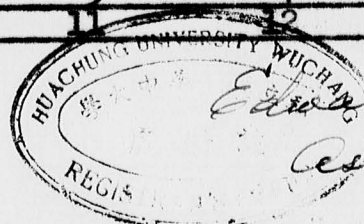

EXCERPTS FROM A LETTER, DATED 29 NOVEMBER, FROM
PRESIDENT WEI, HUACHUNG UNIVERSITY

"I received with gratitude your very cheering letter of November 14. I have shared parts of it with the main administrative officers of the University.

"Enclosed I am sending you a copy of the Minutes of the Executive Committee of the Huachung Board of Directors, held on November 17.

III. Of the full-time teaching staff of 54, 37 are Christians, i.e. 70%, and of the 6 part-time teachers only 2 are Christians, i.e. 33%. Everyone of the 6 part-time teachers is teaching only three hours a week. Of the 21 full-time administrative staff, two-thirds i.e. 66% are Christians.

"You will note that the third year has the smallest number of students, because they were the freshman students at the time of Liberation in May 1949, and that class was most seriously affected.

"Of the total number of 488 students, only 176 have reported themselves as Christians, making 36% of the total enrollment. This percentage of Christian students is about the lowest since rehabilitation four and a half years ago. Of the 176 Christian students, 50 belong to the Episcopal Church in China, 48 to the Church of Christ in China, 34 to the Methodist Church in China, 16 to the Baptist Church, 10 to the Roman Catholic Church, and the remainder are scattered among the other denominations.

"I am very happy to report to you that as far as religious activities in Huachung are concerned, we are very much encouraged by the wonderful spirit manifested by both faculty and students during this present term. Everything is going on as usual, except with greater vigor. It is especially gratifying to find that many of the younger Chinese Christian members of the faculty and staff are taking more interest in religious activities, and it was really on their initiative that the faculty fellowship has been revived, and this fellowship is working out a very interesting program.

"As you will notice from the Minutes of the Executive Committee of the Huachung Board of Directors, we expect a deficit of less than US\$1,000. at the end of the present fiscal year, if prices and payments should remain the same as at present, but prices may go up, and nobody can tell what is going to happen.

"We are expecting, for instance, the return of two of our alumni, now finishing their research work in the United States, one for the teaching of Physical Chemistry, and one for the teaching of English literature. We have just appointed a Chinese teacher of English in Mr. Kwei Ts'an-kuen, B.A., Chekiang University 1943, and M.A. in English Literature, Michigan, 1949. After his M. A. Mr. Kwei had another year of graduate studies in Michigan, and returned to China only this autumn. He is not a Christian, but he seems to be a fine man with the proper spirit. As both Miss Sheets and Dr. Walter Allen of the English department plan to leave in the winter, we have to get at least one more Chinese teacher of English, besides Mr. Kwei, in order to carry the courses required by the students according to the curriculum. That is why we must have one of our alumni, mentioned above, for English Literature as well.

"Then Mrs. Van Sant, teaching part-time Music, Mrs. David Anderson, practically full-time teacher of Music, and Mrs. Walter Allen, teaching practically full-time in Music, will be gone by the end of this term; unless we should find a Chinese teacher of Music, we would not be able to carry on the courses in that department. The extra salaries for next term, if we should get all the teachers I have just mentioned, would amount to about US\$1,000. in addition to our present budget of salaries for the current year.

"It is very good of you to make such complimentary remarks on our administrative 'foursome.' We are really very fortunate in having such fine people for the administrative offices in Huachung, except myself who am getting a little bit too old. I wish to mention also Dr. Edith W. K. Taai, Dean of Women and Professor of Religious Education and Educational Psychology; and Professor John L. Coe, Treasurer of the University for over twenty years. One would have to go a long way to find people like these, who add much to the strength of our administration, and whose loyalty to the cause is never to be doubted."
