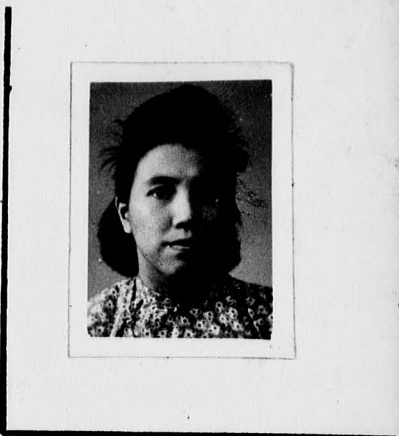

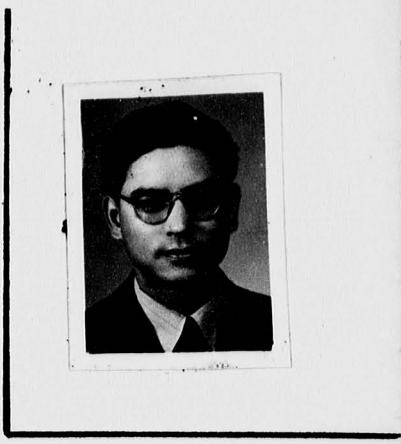

In time of danger with a large body of students and teachers, ^{to take care of} the sense of responsibility for their safety is very strenuous to the Principal. The following are some of the experiences:

- 1) 1938 when we moved the school from Wanchang to Kwangsi by train, we met an air raid. To get students & teachers, families & children down train and find places of hiding near by, and after the raid is over to get them on train again there was great excitement and anxiety.
- 2) At midnight, to evacuate a group of 300 students during air raid is also a big job. To awake them, lead them out of school buildings and take them back in the dark, all these need mental energy and quietness.
- 3) When the Japanese soldiers were approaching our city, our responsibility to our girls students and lady teachers, for their safety, was very pressing. We had no means of transportation, and we have to walk and carry some of our things. This is too much for the girls and ladies.

In April 1938 when I was called upon to lead a group of five St. John's medical graduates and 15 nurses towards Yunnan, I was only told to open one hospital on Yunnan-Burma Highway. When arrived at Kunning, the capital of Yunnan, I was asked to face facts. Drivers were sick, dying. Medical supply - 5 out call bags - were scanty. Proceed for the high way and started five clinics immediately. Transportation must go on. It did. We had only five thousand tablets of quinine, few dozens of small pox vaccine and a few dozen bottles of typhoid and cholera vaccine. We used microscopes and found that the chief manence was malignant malaria. Gave what ever ^{help} we could offer to the drivers and kept the traffic going. The doctors were increased upto twenty-one with fourteen St. John's graduates. At the time of Japanese invasion into Burma we established 9 hospitals on the highway with a total capacity of three hundred beds.

No particularly unusual experience I have had during the war time, except one occasion which made me think deeper about life. It was a beautiful sunny morning when my wife, children and I hurried far into the mountainous field in the suburb of Yüanling, western Hunan, immediately after the first alarm. People flooded out of the city too, for heavy bombing yesterday almost swept out the whole city and over thousand of ~~the~~ its population hurried under fire and fallen houses. Everyone, then, struggled under scare for safety and life like swarms of poor ants out of their damaged caves. I and family sitted under the shades of tung oil trees enjoying the cool breeze after a long sweat running. We waited there till noon time and then came the release. But just before we got sitted in our home again, came instantly the urgent alarm. We could not but crowd ~~ed~~ into a little dug-out nearby. After about five minutes, heavy bombs showered down near and far, fire broke out in several places too. To my great surprise, after release, was the report of an intimate friend, who said, "The tung oil trees under which you sat the moment before were smashed out entirely." After a deep meditation I said to the Lord: "If the life of a little creature poor as an ant is saved purposely, help me, Lord, making it most useful to God and man."

When I was the Chief Secretary for American Chief Adviser's office of Central Aviation Cadet School, Hangchow, 1937, Col. C. L. Chennault (later Maj. General USA) came to China as the Chief Adviser on Aviation. Since then I worked ^{with} Gen. Chennault in CAF thru American Volunteer Group, China Air task Force, USA and 14th USAF for a period of 9 years and till now with Gen. Chennault in CNRRA Air Transport for his relief and rehabilitation work in China. During the war, I have been with Gen. Chennault traveling all territory of free China by air more than 1,000 hours flying for the purpose of inspecting air combat units and studying military situation at front.

Personally, I had watched the air combats and escaped many enemy bombings during the course of the war both at Chungking and Kunming. One time, a ~~big~~ bomb failed about 50 yards from my trench where I stayed nearby the Kunming field. But I came out not injured with ~~all~~ mud all over my body.

In 1941, for the formation of American Volunteer Group headed by Gen. Chennault, I had assisted War Area Service Corps to train more 200 volunteer interpreters and some of these interpreters later worked in US Army forces and even most of them were sent to U.S.A. to work for the training centers of CAF flying crews.

During my service in C.A.F., I have been commissioned to the rank of Colonel in C.A.F. and Major General in Chinese Army. Besides the Legion of Merit, Officer degree, given by U.S. government in 1945, I had five more kinds of decoration from my own country.

I was not bombed fortunately, however, I have had a lot of experiences during air raids. I often liked to look at the Japanese planes except those times in Chungking where dugouts were well prepared.

Another experience which can not be got except during the war time was that when I travelled in Szechwan. I took once a small boat with my wife and two children running down a stream with rocks beneath the surface of the water. That small boat was ^{once} turned ^{nearly} entirely to pieces by the rocks, but fortunately we were saved by other boats, unless we would be all drowned. And once when we were travelling by a bus, it turned over on the highway way up on the mountain. Fortunately we all wounded very lightly.

The experience of the difficulty of earning one's living by his income is also valuable. I remember I sold every thing I had for buying rice and cabbage including a small souvenir — Key to New York — which I brought back from New York when I attended the 25th anniversary of American Boy Scouts.


