Gentlemen:

We have made an examination of the books and records of HUA CHUNG UNIVERSITY

as maintained at the New York office. The accounts of Hua Chung University were formerly in the keeping of the National Council of the Protestant Episcopal Church and were transferred to the custody of the Hua Chung Committee of the United Board for Christian Colleges in China as of November 1, 1948. This report covers the period of eight months from November 1, 1948 to June 30, 1949.

### SCOPE OF AUDIT

The cash balance on deposit with the Irving Trust Company was verified by confirmation received directly by us from the depositary. The balance so certified to us was reconciled to the books.

All vouchers supporting cash disbursements were examined and compared to entries on the books. Authorization and allocation

of charges to accounts as evidenced by approved vouchers and cancelled checks were noted and compared to the books.

Securities were verified by inspection and written confirmation obtained from the custodians.

We have examined the report of the Treasurer of the United Board for Christian Colleges in China to the Hua Chung University Committee and found it to be correct.

The forwarding of funds to China was verified by inspection of vouchers supporting such remittances. The verification of the final disposition of such funds is necessarily covered by audit reports from the field. The field audit report for the period ended June 30, 1949 on Hua Chung University had not been received at the time of preparing this report. Our comments are therefore subject to qualifications which be made necessary by disclosures, if any, in such report.
