Two years after my graduation, the war broke in China. As a wartime social worker, I went with the Chinese Government. For 15 times, I and my family moved here, there and ~~wherever~~ finally returned to my original base. There were hardship and difficulties of course, but, under God's guidance, no loss and damage to me or any one in my family.

During the time when we were in Chungking, we lutheran young people organized ourselves with a refugee church which later changed into a Chungking Lutheran Church. The Lutheran student movement, which is now developing rapidly all over the Lutheran fields in China, was originated in Chungking. As the President of the first Luther League in China, I had many interesting and inspiring stories from the Christian Youth. The Lutheran Church of China discovered the importance of status of the youth to the church from the youth activities in Chungking.

I was confined in the buildings of the Willis F. Pierce Memorial Hospital during the first invasion of Fochon in 1941.

I was at Langhin during the second invasion of Fochon in 1944. Japanese soldiers came to a place two miles away from the hospital. Hospital was ordered to evacuate. Both hospital and staff had less many things at the time of evacuation. Bombs dropped near to the hospital building frequently. We were in tunnels both days and nights, fearing of Japanese soldiers at day time and of bandits at nights.

I am not like others to have done wonders in life. But I have some very deep and personal experiences which I like to share with others.

I cannot and shall not forget what friends, most of them missionaries, in Chengtu did for me when I was ill. Their generous kindness and loving care rebuilt my health, spiritually and physically. They took care of me who was homeless and in extreme despair in my future life work. Their warm homes and kind hearts made me live and changed my own view toward the aged and the sick. In helping them, you have not only <sup>lent</sup> given them a hand but a heart and religion of love and forgiveness.

Boys or girls who had been my students used to call me 'Mother'. I would feel uneasy but flattered. When they came for advice, I gave all I considered best to them. When they left school, they continued to write me about their ideals and plans, joy or sorrow. I thought I did very well as a teacher until last year when my daughter got into trouble with a boy friend. (One of the students became my daughter). I discovered myself inadequate and unqualified to be a mother, or, a teacher, whose understanding love and tact could prevent her children from being perplexed by love affairs. By that experience, painful and heart-breaking, I returned to God, our Heavenly Father, for strength and love and forgiveness. I made up my mind to help all the young people who might come into contact with me to build their personality and life on Jesus Christ.

The school was bombed by the Japanese bombers in Chungking. Most of the school buildings were bombed. We had to move our school to a small county 60 miles from Chungking. It was a very hard time for us.

Every time when the Japanese bombed Chungking, there was always an air alarm; and when it came we didn't know where to put 350 students. Then we dug a cave under a deep high hill that could hold about four hundred people. When the air alarm came each adviser of that class took her students to the cave even in the mid of the night we had to do so. Sometimes the Japanese bombers came 5 or 6 times a day we had to escape in the cave every time. Although it was tiresome yet we kept on our work. Teachers and girls worked together in harmony for the final victory and the Kingdom of God. Japanese could only fire us physically but could not kill us spiritually!

During the beginning of the war <sup>1937</sup>, we had to evacuate from west-gate because of the bombing. We established a small pre-natal hospital in a private primary school for 2 months. Finally we were able to rent the site of an old Orthopedic Hospital which belonged to a deceased Orthopedic Surgeon. - In 1942, when our American Colleagues were first interned and then sent back to the States, we were left to maintain the hospital. Our financial status was very limited. We depended on only whatever we could charge from the patients which was very meager because most of our patients belonged to middle and poorer classes. The staffs were underpaid, poorly fed and over worked. Thank the Lord that we were able to maintain our standard and got all the cooperation we could expect to get.

Aside from the above difficulties, we had to think of ways and means to get the Japanese from taking over the Hospital. We succeeded in keeping away from the hospital.

In the summer <sup>1945</sup> many bombs were aimed at the vicinity of the Hospital - we were fortunate enough not being directly hit. The nearest one landed about one block from the Hospital. Shortly before the V. J. day - the bombing was so bad that scared away most of our patients and the workers. That period was so short that we were glad to say that we did not close even for one day since we moved to the new site.
