Enclosed herewith is a Balance Sheet for Shantung Christian University as of June 30, 1957 together with a Statement of Receipts and Disbursements for the fiscal year July 1, 1956 to June 30, 1957, which have been prepared by the Auditors, Messrs. Chambellan, Berger and Welti. These statements have been prepared as Exhibit J of the Report of the Treasurer to the United Board.

Since all contact with our beloved University in China has been discontinued and since no funds were sent to China during the fiscal year 1956-57, the activity in the University accounts was reduced to a minimum. The annual report of the Treasurer to the United Board will be presented in a form that will give a complete financial picture of the stewardship of the United Board including its administration of those funds it holds for the various Universities.

At the present time, all cash and investment assets with the exception of 100 shares of James MacMullen Company stock, Chefoo, China, valued at \$1.00, are held by the United Board for the benefit of the Shantung Christian University and are included in the United Board Treasurer's Report.
