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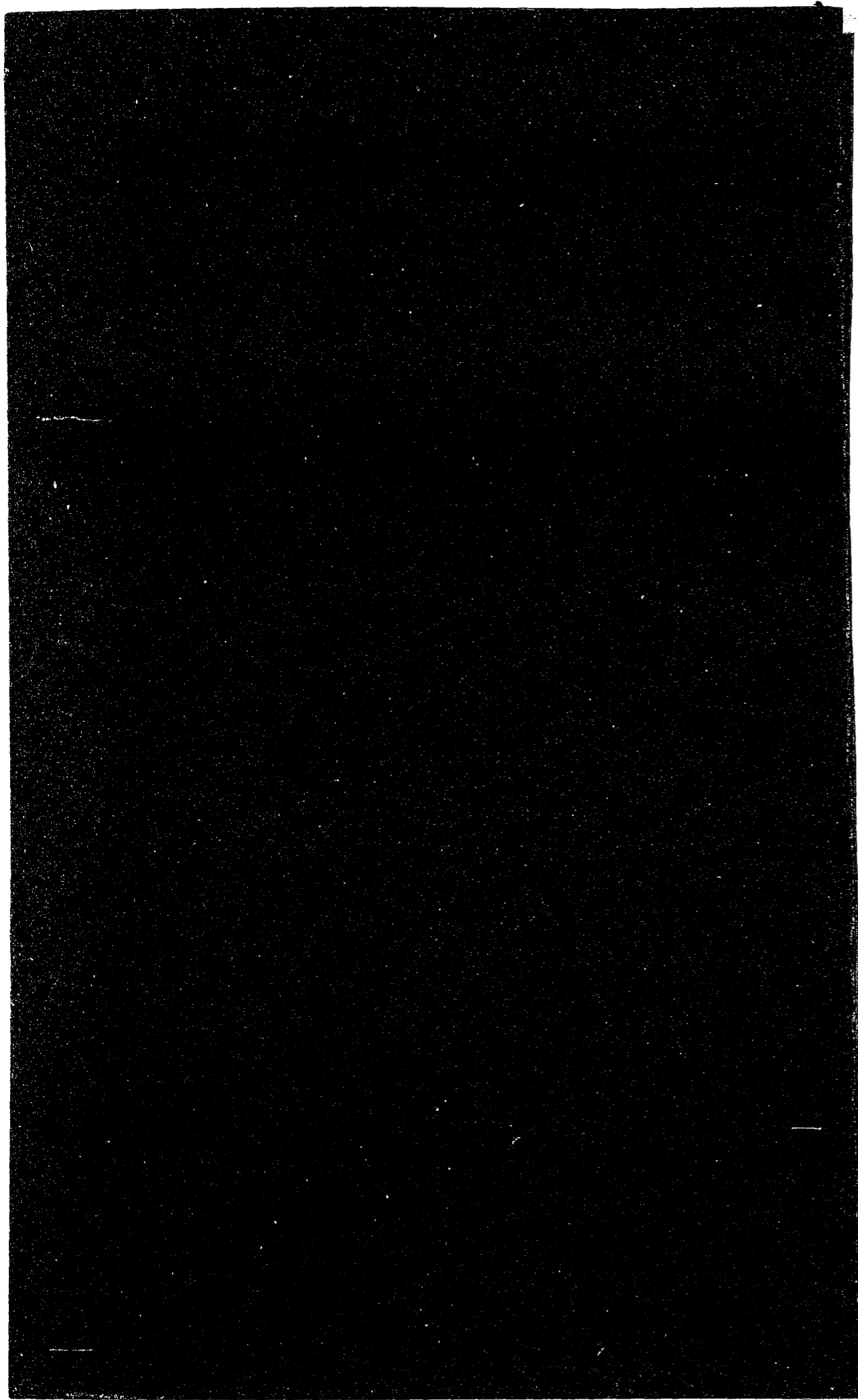

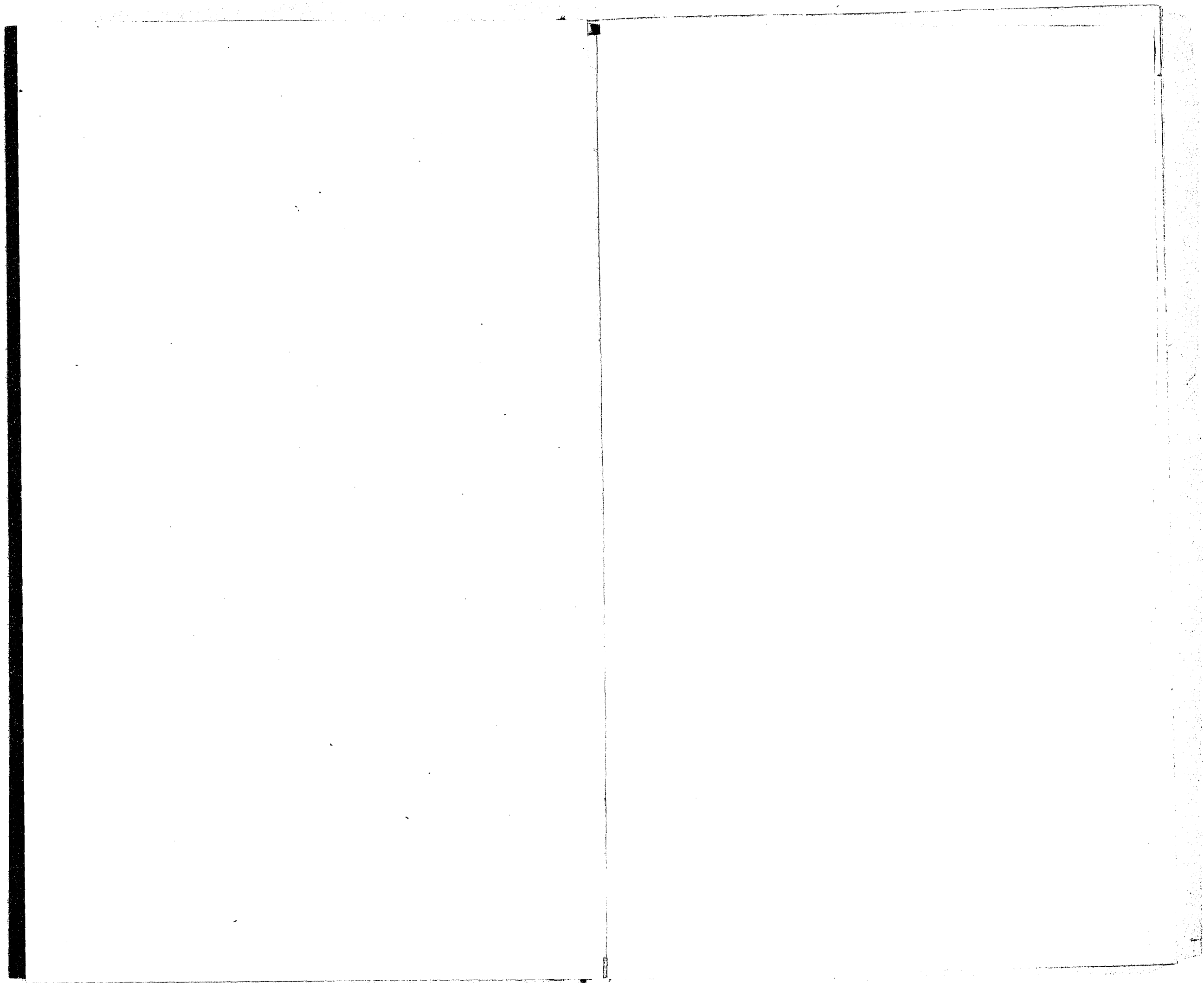

## A TRIBUTE TO MY LATE HUSBAND

**I**N these three days of my deep mourning for my most esteemed and beloved husband, I can hardly collect myself to write even a sentence. Yet my grief compels me to express something of my inner-most feeling at this moment.

On February 23rd, 1924, we were united for one great cause—, to render better service to humanity and to set out together for a higher purpose in life. During these thirteen years many physical relapses of his and mine, many disappointments and discouragements in facing our life's great task, many a storm and stress in overcoming my husband's physical handicaps, have knit us closer into a deeper spiritual bond and made us live close to each other. We could almost read each others' minds. He often remarked, "No one on earth understands me better than you do in my strivings for a higher goal." He confided in me everything about his medical work, the difficulties of starting the organization of this Orthopedic Surgery, and how he had to operate with a non-specialized team in a poorly equipped building.

During a period of six years, his contact with 5,600 cases revealed his indomitable courage in handling them. He never let a single opportunity slip for thinking out a better treatment for any patient. Each patient was his friend. The children loved him.

Since 1915 he had suffered from an ulcerated stomach, and in 1924, five days after our wedding, he was operated on for a perforated stomach. This imposed upon him the everlasting ban of a limited and tasteless diet which continually tortured him. He had to read newspapers to forget what he was eating. But the last seven months was the hardest and the greatest trial of all.

In 1934 when he was struck down with diphtheria, followed later by chronic nephritis I can never forget the agony and shock he went through. One day, he did not speak until late in the evening when he said: "My dear, your life will be a sacrifice from now on. I shall die a slow death. There will be even a harder fight than what we have been through—diseased kidneys and a depressed mind. I am physically crippled." Then he sobbed like a helpless child. I promised that I would stand by him and suffer with him. He said, "I am compelled to lay down my sword—the surgeon's knife." Then he looked at his trembling hands—"This pair of hands, of what use are they? I am now on the Altar." He loved his orthopedic surgery as an engineer does his machinery. A poor boy's finger or a worker's hand meant so much to him. He did everything for a laborer's son to save his middle finger from amputation. He kept the boy one and a half years, fed him, clothed the boy and educated him. Finally, he healed that finger and returned the boy to his laborer-father with pride, "Now you go back with a perfect hand." Then he told his staff, "How

much workers depend upon their hands. You must save unnecessary amputation or chopping off." But his own hands, trained and skilled, sensitive to the slightest difference of bone derangement, are sacrificed on the Altar!

Then the next day he saw a new vision, "I know what I'll do. I'll devote my whole energy to the Chinese Medical Association. It needs stabilizing and strengthening forces. It's a piece of work nobody cares for but full of vast potentialities for the health of our country. I'll try to put it on the right track." So I promised that we would change our line of attack and fight for a better and more united Medical Association. For the last three years that organization has been the central object of his devotion. Again he grieved for not having found his successors. So he watched and observed until he found greatest satisfaction in three colleagues, Drs. H. P. Chu, Szeming Sze, and W. S. Fu. He spoke of them as his jewels, "They are my gems, pearl, ruby and diamond." With these three to carry on his work, my husband said that he could die in peace feeling that the Medical Association was on the safe road to a higher level as he knew that these colleagues stood for the same ideals as his own for the work he had loved so much. Even on the day before his farewell to us when he was almost delirious—he talked to his immediate colleagues, commending the work of the Association to them.



Here, I would like to pay a tribute to the brave team of Doctors who had made it possible for him to enjoy the last Medical Conference the climax of his life's happiness. His spirit had never soared so high as it did then since his collapse. On March 28, he wrote his Will and on April 1st he marched into the Conference with a victorious spirit, dauntless and full of enthusiasm, and on May 4th he entered in to rest.

I would like to express my tearful gratitude to Drs. H. H. Morris, W. S. Fu, P. C. Tung and their wives who stood by us in the last seven months. They acted like brave warriors, realizing it was fatal yet keeping on the battle with the spartan spirit. Sixteen blood transfusions were made from my late husband's own friends.

Drs. W. S. Fu, Szeming Sze, T. A. Li, L. S. Woo, C. Y. Chen, four medical students of the National Medical College Mr. W. K. Chen and three Marine Friends.

Thirty-two other friends and relatives volunteered and had their blood examined and typed.

It was a hard struggle for a suffering doctor with an incurable disease. But oh, what magnificent love and sympathy were shown to him until the very last. When Dr. Fu gave his blood for the 2nd time, he was much moved, "I don't deserve such treatment, why bother?"

For myself, these brave doctors gave me staying power to share my husband's agony until he joined our Heavenly Father whose Love and Mercy have no bounds.

Another source of power has been the sympathetic support of my relatives and friends with their constant loving remembrances of us in our times of trial and tribulation.

But the main spring of our strength comes from the Divine Power who controls the whole Universe and always has a deeper meaning for us to seek after. The lease of life He had given to my beloved husband was, indeed, well-used.

I wish to close with this passage from Dr. Fosdick's book, "The Power to see it through."—a book which has helped me much these days. "What is the most lamentable tragedy in human life? To face suffering, to be cruelly handicapped; Surely not! For we have seen some terribly handicapped people who had such moral staying power that they came through to a great conclusion, all their flags flying when they came into port."

WAY-SUNG NEW, surgeon; born at Shanghai, June 14, 1892; son of the late Shang-chow New, one of the early Chinese students sent to America; received his primary education under private tutors and attended St. John's Middle School, 1902-07; studied at St. John's University, 1907-10 and received his A.B. degree; went to America and studied at Harvard Medical School, 1910-14 and received his M.D. degree; house physician and surgeon at St. Luke's Hospital, New Bedford, 1914-15; returned to China in August, 1915 and took charge of the department of anatomy at Harvard Medical School of China, Shanghai from 1915-16 and then went again to America as a fellow of the Rockefeller Foundation; served in the out-patient department of the Carney Hospital, Boston, the Children's Hospital and the Massachusetts General Hospital as orthopedic assistant, 1916-17; at the same time he was instructor in bacteriology at Harvard Medical School; orthopedic house surgeon at Massachusetts General Hospital, 1917-18; orthopedic assistant at Johns Hopkins Hospital from May to July, 1918, when he returned to China to take charge of orthopedic surgery at Peking Union Medical College, which office he held until June, 1920; he was admitted as a member of the Boylston Medical Society on presenting a thesis on "Acute Anterior Poliomyelitis" in March 1913; he became a fellow of the American Medical Association and a member of the Massachusetts Medical Society and a member of the American Orthopedic Association; was licensed to practise medicine by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in 1917; he was a charter member of the National Medical Association of China when it was inaugurated in 1915; the same

year he was elected a member of the China Medical Missionary Association; he served as secretary of the Peking Medical Society, 1919-20; secretary of St. John's Alumni Association of Peking, 1919-20; secretary-treasurer of Harvard Club of North China, 1919-20; secretary of American University Club of North China, 1919-20; secretary of the National Medical Association of China, 1915-16 and 1920-22; treasurer of the National Medical Association of China, 1922; President of National Medical Association of China, 1930-32; councillor of the Shanghai Medical Society, 1921-23; president of the Shanghai Medical Society, 1923-24; member of the executive committee of the China Medical Missionary Association, 1923-32; secretary of St. John's Alumni Association, 1921-22; president of the St. John's Alumni Association, 1929; secretary-treasurer of St. John's University Alumni Advisory Council, 1922; and national secretary of Phi Tau Phi, 1922; he has been visiting orthopedic surgeon at the Margaret Williamson Hospital, Shanghai, and consulting orthopedic surgeon at Soochow Hospital, Soochow, since 1920; he has also been medical officer to the Yangtze River Commission, the Whangpoo River Conservancy, medical adviser to the Shanghai-Hangchow-Ningpo Railway and the Shanghai-Nanking Railway; he was honorary superintendent of the Chinese Infectious Diseases Hospital as well as the Lung Hua Clinic and the Tung Ka Doo Clinic; he was also medical director of the National Child Welfare Association; in 1927 he was elected a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons, being the first and only Chinese who has received this degree of F.A.C.S.; he is a member of Sinim Lodge of Shanghai

East and is chief surgeon and superintendent; at the amalgamation of the National Medical Association of China and the China Medical Association to form the Chinese Medical Association in 1932, he was elected to serve as its first President; he is now Chairman of the Executive Committee of the Chinese Medical Association; he is a member of the Shanghai Medical Board of the Shanghai Municipal Council; address: 850 Route de Zi-ka-wei, Shanghai.

August 27, 1934

This letter sent from Tsingtao to Dr. New's brother-in-law, Mr. P. T. Zee was the first written by him since the beginning of his illness in February. Mr. Zee was undertaking full responsibility for Dr. New's Orthopedic Hospital during his absence.

My dear Kohling,

I am having so much joy and am feeling so well that I must take this opportunity to write you a few lines. You do not know how much I appreciate what you and Ruth are doing for the hospital and for me personally, and words of mine cannot adequately express my gratitude. It is on occasions like this when one is in distress that "a friend in need is a friend indeed", and here you are more than a friend. I am now not worrying about the hospital, as I know that things will go well with you at the helm and with God guiding you. I am, however, concerned about your health, for if you overwork and

(2) get ill, then there might be a collapse of the hospital. Please do not undertake any unnecessary work, but just let things "go easy" till cooler weather comes.

This illness of mine has taught me many things. I was often fond of watching big fires. After the fires were over, and the houses had burnt to ashes, the owners (or rather the previous owners) used to prod over the ruins. They knew fully well that everything combustible was turned into ashes, but there may be a chance that some silver dollars, being heavy and less destructible than wood or cotton, might have sunk to the bottom of the ashes, thus escaping the hot flames.

③ These could be salvaged and  
be used for capital to start ~~the~~  
life over again. Then again, the  
image of Yuan Shih Kai or Sun Yat Sen  
on the silver dollar may be blurred  
or destroyed by the heat. That does  
not render the dollar useless,  
for the intrinsic value of silver is  
still there. In fact, that lump of silver  
could now be of better use, for as a  
"dollar" it could only be used as "money"  
& the law prohibits its being melted for  
other uses! As a lump of silver, it  
could be made use of for any purpose.  
You are probably wondering what  
I am driving at, but here is the  
Explanation.

My illness has been a big disaster  
to me - a big loss - It has left

(4) me completely burnt out — my  
"plans", my ambitions, my pride,  
my everything! During these weeks  
of confinement, I have prodded  
the ruins of this fire — I find  
ashes everywhere, too soft and flaky  
for reconstruction — the reconstruction  
of that type of structure I had planned  
for — I shall no longer operate — my  
career as an orthopedic surgeon finished.  
The hospital can no longer expect  
to be known as Dr. W. Stew's ortho-  
pedic Hospital, the only one of its kind  
efficiently run, clean, etc! No,  
everywhere I stepped, my feet  
sank into the ashes — Most  
disheartening, isn't it? But  
presently, my foot hit upon

something - Instead of soft ashes, it  
stropped upon hard substance - I reach  
my fingers for it - Lo and behold!  
What have I found! I found  
"Gold" with which I could start  
life again - Like the silver dollars

found had its tarnishes - the  
worldly evils - the evils of  
hell - destroyed - I found pure  
gold, with this formula: -

GOLD - L (HELL) = GOD

So at last, out of my  
illness + confinement, I have  
found God, and I am

only capital, I might be given  
another chance to start life!

I am feeling better every  
day & the new hope is dawning  
in the East - In two more  
weeks, I am coming home

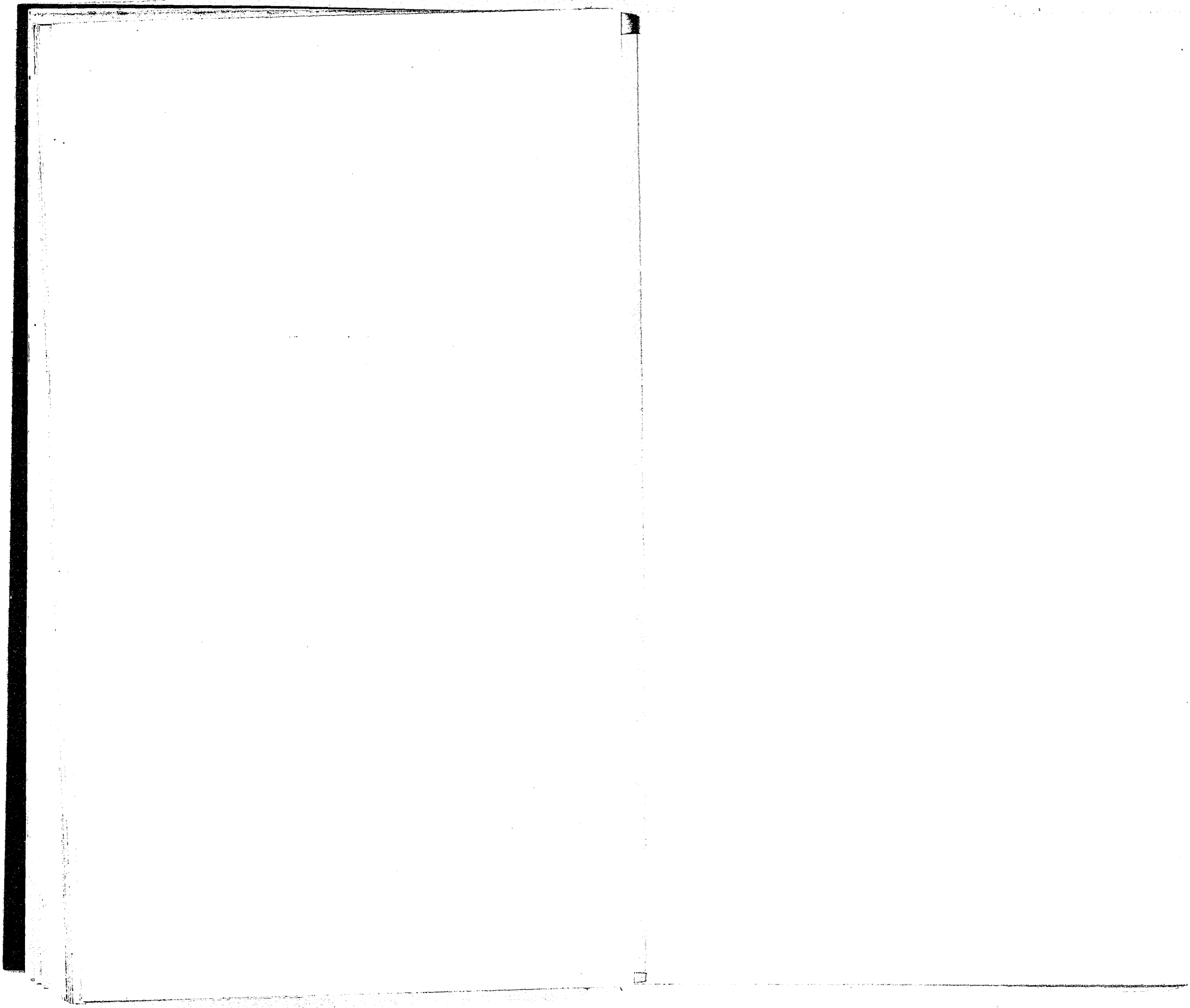
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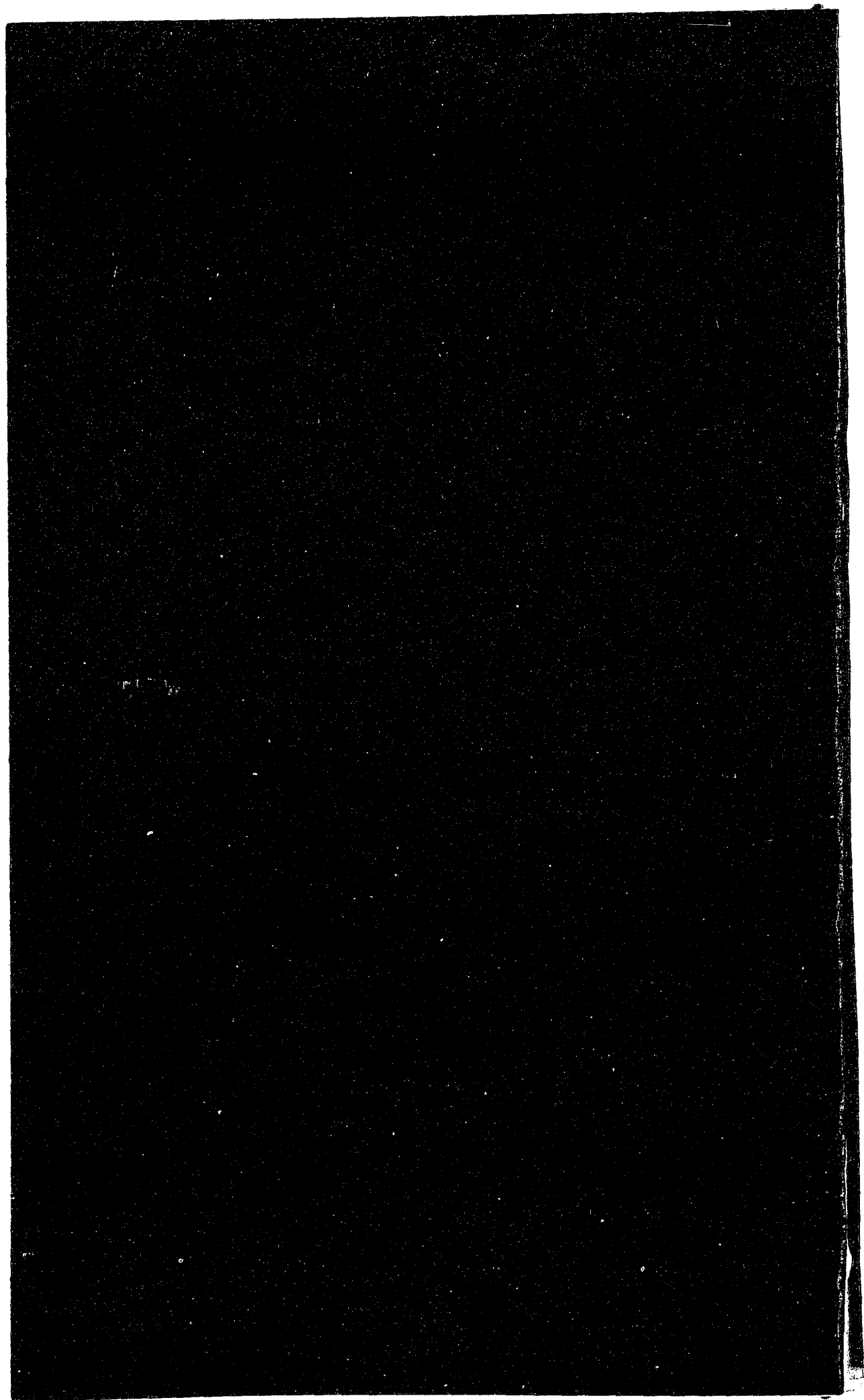

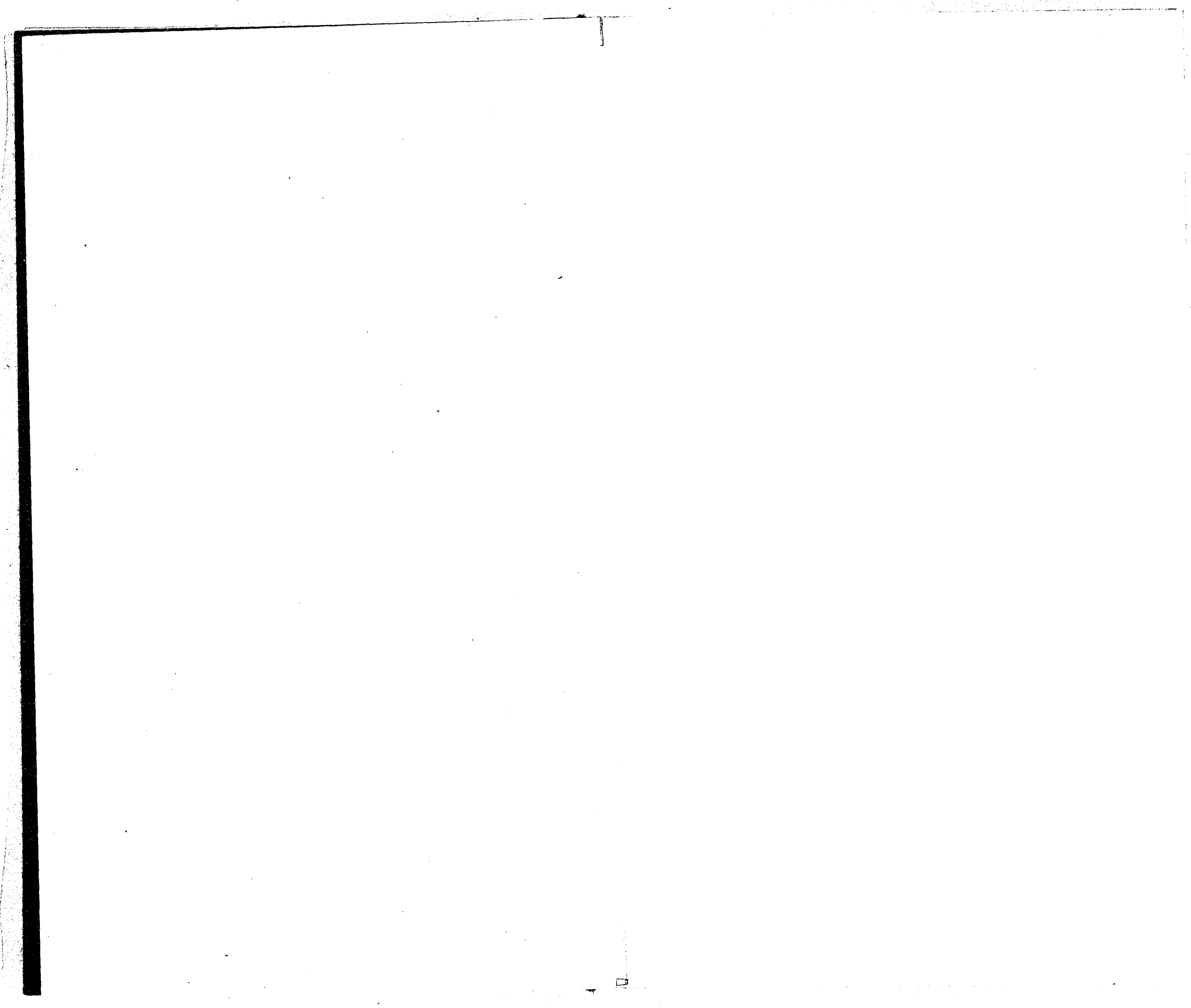

We were taking care of the British & American camp patients in the Country Hospital in Shanghai. Naturally, we became good friends to most of them; and we helped in carrying their messages, passing on the news, bringing them gifts and even lending money to them, which were of course against the rules of the hospital. On the day when I had just given some money from my chief to one of the patients, the Japanese Superintendent called me to his office and questioned me. He said that he had discovered that I passed on something to the patients. I had to admit it and I chose the most innocent thing to say - the hot water bottles which I brought from our own hospital to the British & American patients. I was ordered to take them back, which I did. That's how I escaped the Japanese Censorship.

While we were in Shanghai during Japanese occupation, I must say that we suffered more on the spiritual side than on material side. Although we had rations in everything but we suffered most on account of our loss of freedom. In my case I had been a student all during the war. Fortunately I majored in medicine so the Japanese couldn't change our textbooks from English to Japanese or Chinese. But simple studies were all that the Japanese allowed us. Students were forbidden to have meetings, activities etc. We couldn't speak out what we wanted to say and later on we weren't even allowed to think freely.

Once I was summoned to the Japanese Gendarme Head quarters merely because of the fact that I received a New Year's card from <sup>Sun mi-ching</sup> 三民主義青年團. I managed to answer all their foolish questions and got out alright. But that morning gave me and my family enough worry and fright.

ANNUAL REPORT

By the President

June 30, 1955

Dear Johannean:

Another year has been added to the history of our Alumni Association, here in New York, and once again it is time to review what has happened to the Association in the past twelve months.

AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION

At the very first cabinet meeting, the members of the Executive Committee discovered that certain parts of our Constitution were obsolete and needed revision. After a careful study, the Executive Committee proposed a few amendments and, in the General Meeting of November 26, 1954, a motion to adopt the Constitution as amended was made, seconded, and unanimously carried. Later on, this amended Constitution was ratified by mail by a majority of members. Among these amendments were two major changes, namely, (1) the Nomination Committee for nominating officers is to be appointed by the Executive Committee rather than elected by the members, and (2) the one-year term of office of all officers is to begin on July 1st and end on June 30th of the following year instead of duplicating the calendar year.

THE DIAMOND JUBILEE

In keeping with a quality-rather-than-quantity policy, the Executive Committee decided to hold just two General Meetings within its tenure of office. The first such meeting took place in the evening of November 26, 1954 at St. Peter's Lutheran Church of Manhattan, New York City. The program was specially arranged to celebrate the Diamond Jubilee of our Alma Mater and highlighted by a warm greeting and speech by the Rev. William Z. L. Sung, our former President of the University. About 80 alumni and their families and friends came to attend. The interesting, original skits, the delicious refreshments plus a huge birthday cake, the reminiscent singing of our "Light & Truth", and the endless chatting among all made the evening a memorable occasion for everyone.

THE ANNUAL MAY OUTING

At 9:30 a.m., Sunday, May 22, 1955, more than 160 alumni and their families and friends took a boat ride up the scenic Hudson River to Indian Point Park, America's largest picnic-recreation-amusement park. Obliging sunshine and beautiful landscape at the Park created a delightful picnicking mood while the substantial "box-luncheonrama" provided the necessary energy for a full afternoon of sports and amusements. The group returned to New York around 9 p.m. This was our Annual May Outing as well as our second General Meeting.



DIRECTORY SUPPLEMENTS

Because of financial limitations, the Directory of St. John's University Alumni Association (in the United States) has not been completely revised in the past year. Instead, two Supplements to the Directory were compiled. The first one was distributed in November, 1954 and the second one is herewith enclosed.



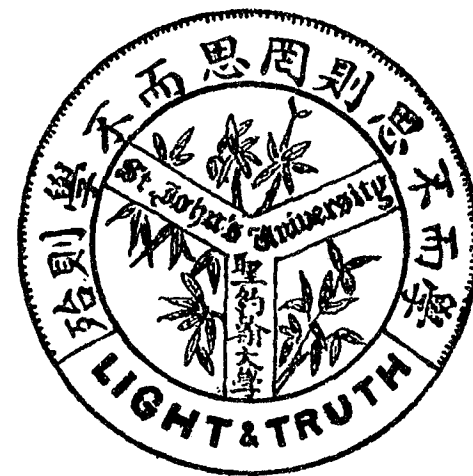

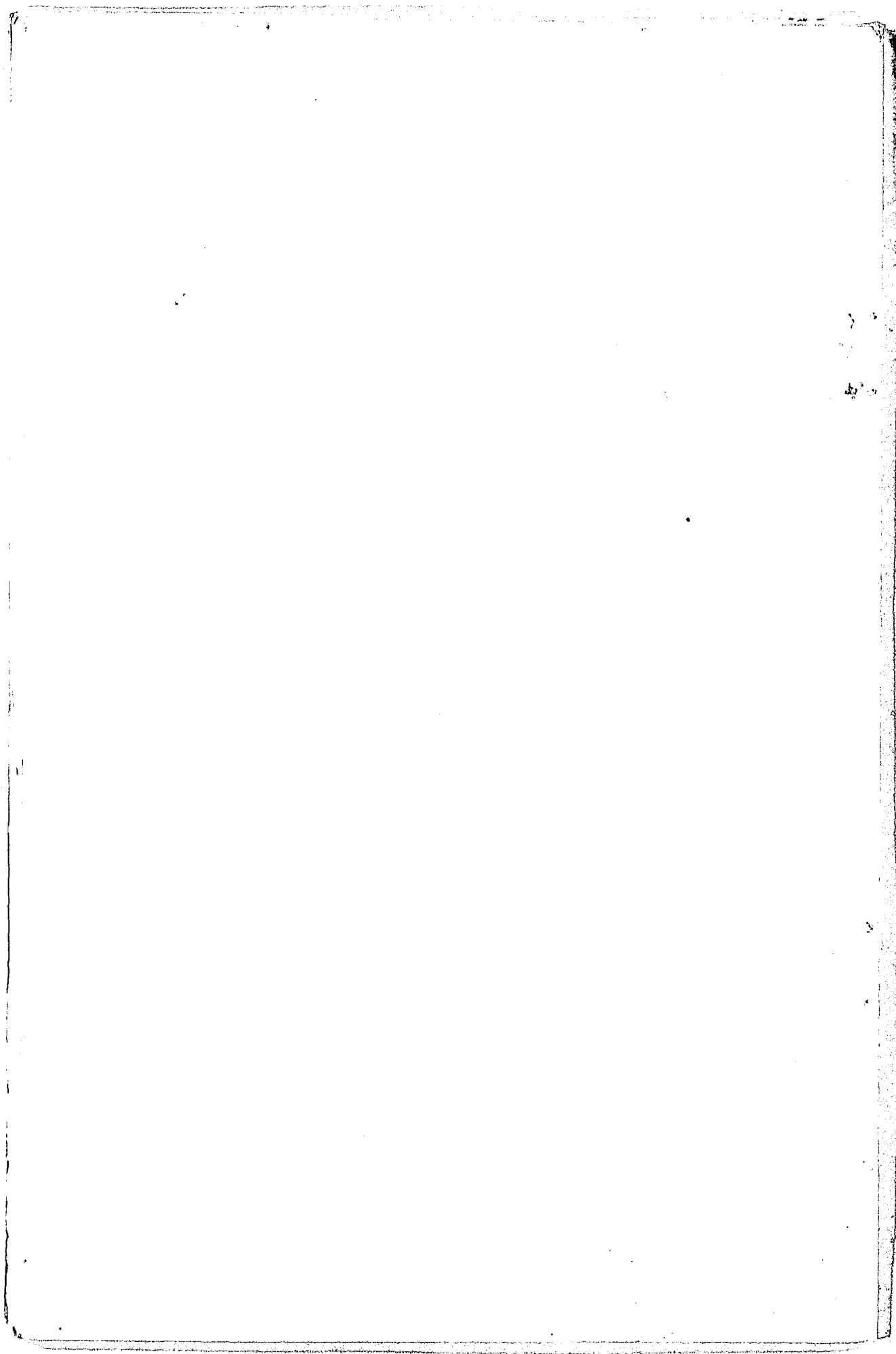
