In the war-time because I was called to help the government in agricultural extension and farmers' organization & training, I travelled extensively in the south western China. I met Japanese bomber planes many times and the bombs were fallen in just short distances to the places where I hid.

On account of Japanese occupation all my personal property ~~was~~ were lost. I used to have a large collection of books, but there is not a single copy left after the war. My personal residence ^{in Hankow} was half burnt at the outbreak of the war. All the material were lost. I also owned an apiary and a farm at Chuchow. All the bees and equipment were completely destroyed by the Japanese soldiers. Thus the war has completely wiped out my personal properties.

terrible bombing experience in Chengtu. At supper all of a sudden we heard
a thundering explosion; immediately the sky turned almost black and
the air stifling. Before we could utter a word, parts of our shing hick
house, two stories high, collapsed and we were dropped flat on the
ground from the first floor. As we were thus taken completely unaware,
lying there stunned I then prayed pleadingly for an explanation of
all the chaos. With my head as heavy as millstones, I supported it
with both of my hands. When I found my white garment was dyed most
part deep red and my hands were smudged all over with hot blood,
I began to realize the situation and yelled at the top of my voice
names of our whole family, twelve of them in that house, to ascertain
their safety and their very existence. When they all responded at
different intervals, I felt completely and perfectly satisfied and murmured
thanks to the Unseen Hand. With that help and care, we walked
out from the ruins, but the next day all our friends marvelled
at our miraculous escape, as they could hardly trace any possible
path whereby we could get ourselves out from such dangerously
damaged house, yet we came out without any fear and hindrance
as fresh and easily as Daniel's three friends came out from the great
fire. This bombing experience has greatly strengthened our faith and enriched
our spiritual lives.



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

From Sept. 1938 I came back to the College of Agriculture, Univ. of Nanking for teaching and research work.
37. PLEASE TELL BRIEFLY ABOUT ANY UNUSUAL EXPERIENCES YOU HAVE HAD. FOR EXAMPLE, WERE YOU INTERNED, CAPTURED, BOMBED, ETC? In my boyhood, when I studied in the primary school of my native town, at an afternoon in Autumn, the robbers came to the town. One of my relatives came to the school and told me that my home was robbed, then she brought me and my brother to conceal in a small cottage until the night. When we came back home with hunger, we saw everything had been put in disorder. A safe box and a piano (China made) had been chopped into pieces. (2) When Just after my graduation from College, I came to Sian, Shensi and worked in Shanghai Commercial & Savings Bank. On Dec. 12th, 1936, Generalissimo Chiang was kidnapped. I was awoken with surprise at the dawn, when a soldier came in the bank, he put his gun with shooting gesture toward me, and ordered me to give him the key for the safe. Then I told him with trembling tone that I was not the manager neither the cashier. Then he went to find the manager (3) At Chengtu, I lived in the University Faculty dormitory with my family. The building is of straw cottage, so it is easy to catch fire. All the residents there were fearing the unexpected firing one day for several years. During May, 1946, the University began to remove to Nanking. Some of the faculty members had gone first by turn. On May 7, 1946, two days before my leave from Chengtu, the dormitory caught fire from neighboring house. My babies were so frightened with shrill cry, and my wife took care of them. My colleague, our old maid-servant and I carried out the belongings hurriedly from the house before it is on fire. And I had never put so large a package on my back as this time. I had been covered with sweat which had become salt particles.

Japanese in the year of 1937, I was still in Peiping. A
base hospital was operated by the Peiping Union Medical
College, sponsored by the International Red Cross Association,
taking care of 800 wounded soldiers left by the Chinese
Army during the retreat. When this city was under
the law of the Japanese, the pressure on the hospital
became tense every day. The Japanese military
authorities claimed that all the wounded
soldiers are their prisoners, and requested the Red
Cross Base Hospital turn over all the patients to
them. Meantime, quarrels were very active within
and outside the city. I managed to smuggle most
of the patients to free China, and thus the Japanese
watched me very closely. In the year of 1939, before
the outbreak of war in Pacific, I ran away, & went
to Chungking. In spite of transportation difficulties,
& searching & cross questioning of the Japanese
landowners at various places, I had arrived
at Chungking in safety.
