

Thank you for your letter of the 25th, and the enclosed material about Yenching.

Following your suggestion I have checked with Mrs. Simmons of the Boston United China Relief Committee regarding our proposed program for raising funds for Yenching. She in turn checked with the headquarters of the United War Fund in Boston. I was then told that, because we plan to give some entertainment in return for money received, and since this will not be a direct bid for donations, we need not clear with United China Relief as this is classified as a private benefit program.

I hope you find the answer satisfactory, for we don't want get the Associated Boards into trouble with the United China Relief.

I have glanced over the descriptions of the slides and moving pictures that you have, and they make me extremely homesick already. Can you tell us when they will be available, and whether or not you have the machines and screen for projection? I note that the slides and pictures are all of Peiping and our campus there. Perhaps this is asking too much, but do you have any pictures or slides of Yenching in Chengtu? Don't you think that the comparison of the former with the latter will be even more effective?

We haven't decided upon the date for the program as yet, for that will depend upon our getting the pictures from you and a hall from elsewhere. However we hope to have it as early in March as possible.

Dear Mrs. Ku:

You have done very well in clearing with the Boston Committee and we congratulate you. As long as you carry on in the manner which you have indicated, by the selling of tickets, and as the Boston Committee has approved, there is nothing to hinder you from that score.

Pictures which we have listed are available any time you may designate as none of them are spoken for in the immediate future. We should know as soon as possible, however.

I am sorry that we do not have anything about Chengtu. Many pictures have been taken and we have small negatives of a great variety of interests, but none are good enough to warrant our investing the money in making slides of them. Two things make it extremely difficult; one is the securing of photographic film and the other the local weather conditions in Chengtu.

In checking on the possibility of sending you the moving picture machine and screen, we are advised against doing so at this time because of existing conditions in transportation. One of our young ladies coming down from Boston lost a valuable parcel, and that is a common occurrence. Shipping facilities are overcrowded and valuable parcels often left in the open, and if destroyed by the weather there is no recourse as the company takes refuge in the "act of God" phrase in the shipping indenture.

The cost of transportation back and forth also is a very considerable item, and you probably could rent equipment in Boston for much less than the transportation charges from New York. There are firms which make a business of renting equipment and I would suggest that you get in touch with some of them.

I must admit there is not much of an appeal in showing the old pictures of Yenching at Peking. You will have to decide whether or not

other features are obtainable which would prove more attrative.

In addition we will have some stylized Chinese modern dances performed by a group of Chinese girls. In order to time our program, and arrange items on the program sheet to be printed, we will have to see the slides and movies before the actual showing. Do you think you could send us the pictures for a preview tentatively arranged for April 17? We could return the pictures to you, if you should by chance need them between the latter date and May 2nd. I presume that the movies are 16 mm. Kindly advise me if they are not of this size.

In your letter you mentioned some negatives of Yenching in Chengtu. We would like to see them, or any prints, if possible, as arrangements might be made for screening them somehow.




