V. PROSPECTS FOR THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR:

1. UNIVERSITY GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS. Beginning with the next academic year the University will each year offer four Graduate Scholarships of \$400 each to the best students entering the Graduate Yuan.
2. ADDITIONAL NORTH CHINA COUNCIL FELLOWSHIPS. For the next academic year the North China Council will offer thirteen additional fellowships of \$600 each besides travelling allowance to be distributed as follows: 5 in Education, 2 in Political Science, 6 in Sociology.

VI. PROBLEMS AHEAD:

With the increasing number of graduate students and with additional funds made available for research, the following problems present themselves to the administration of the Graduate Yuan:

1. How to effect more efficient supervision of all the research work going on in the University in order to maintain a high and more or less uniform scholastic standard.
2. How to bring about a better coordination of the different lines of research in the University.
3. How to make possible a better coordination of the undergraduate and post-graduate work in the University.


