# V. PROSPECTS FOR THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR:

- 1. UNIVERSITY GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS. Beginning with the next academic year the University will each year offer four Gaduate Scholarships of \$400 each to the best students entering the Graduate Yuan.
- 2 ADDITIONAL NORTH CHINA COUNCIL FELLOWSHIPS. For the next academic year the North China Council will offer thirteen additional fellowships of \$600 each besides travelling allowance to be distributed as follows: 5 in Education, 2 in Political Science, 6 in Sociology.

## VI . PROBLEMS AREAD:

With the increasing number of graduate students and with additional funds made available for research, the following problems present themselves to the administration of the Graduate Yuan:

- How to effect more efficient supervision of all the research work going on in the University in order to maintein a high and more or less uniform scholastic standard.
- 2. How to bring about a better coordination of the different lines of research in the University.
- 3. How to make possible a better coordination of the undergraduate and post graduate work in the University.
