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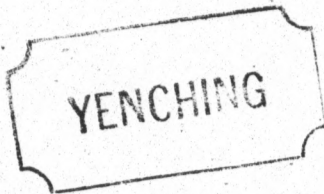

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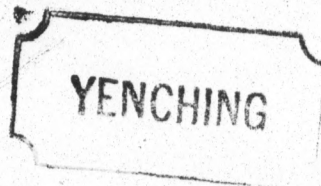

Dear Dr. Stuart:

Your code cable to hand. I have just talked with Mr. Gee on the telephone who informs me that favorable action has been taken by the Yenching Trustees concerning the Institute of Rural Administration and I shall receive a letter from Mr. Garside about this in a day or two.

I wrote you under date of March 26 that things were moving slowly here. Since then it has become apparent that no definitive action with regard to China will be taken at the April 11th meeting. This is due to unforeseen circumstances. Certain prominent Trustees are out of the country and cannot be present at this meeting, and a special Trustees' committee of review, which was to report at the April meeting on the present program of the Foundation and future policies, is only going to make an interim report. The Chinese item is merely one of many which will have to be postponed. After the April meeting is over I expect to have information as to when the meeting at which decisions will be taken will be held and I shall keep you informed. This unforeseen complication is a serious disappointment to me but entirely beyond my control.

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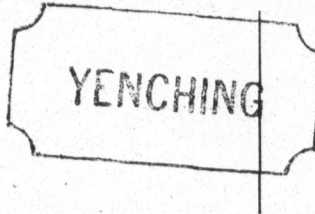



Dear President Stuart:

I am enclosing herewith official letter from Mrs. Thompson with regard to an additional appropriation of Five thousand (\$5,000) dollars for the Department of Public Affairs for the year beginning July 1, 1934. 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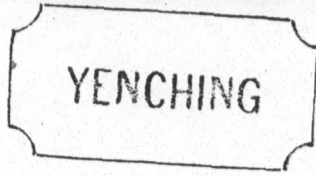

My dear Mr. Barber:

I have the honor to inform you that at a meeting of The Rockefeller Foundation on April 11, 1934, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, prior to April 13, 1932, various appropriations were made by The Rockefeller Foundation specified as endowment funds, the incomes of which were specified as to purpose, and

WHEREAS, The Rockefeller Foundation on April 13, 1932, adopted the following statement of policy with respect to each gift for capital purposes:

It is the desire of The Rockefeller Foundation that this gift, whether the income only is spent or the principal as well, shall always be regarded as available for use in the broadest way so as best to promote the general purpose for which it is made. With this in mind, the following provisions have been drawn:

1. If at any time the institution or institutions then holding the gift enter into consolidation or merger with another institution or institutions, any new institution thus created shall be free to use the gift in accordance with the provisions in paragraphs numbered three and four of this memorandum.
2. If at any time in the judgment of those then responsible for the use of the gift the general purpose for which it was made can thereby be better served, the gift may be transferred in whole or in part to some other institution or institutions, the new holder or holders to be free to use it in accordance with the provisions in paragraphs numbered three and four of this memorandum.

3. Ten years after the date of the gift, if, in the judgment of those then responsible for its use, the general purpose for which it was made can thereby be better served, the income may be used in whole or in part for some specific purpose other than that for which the gift was originally made, such specific purpose to be as closely akin to the original purpose as may be found practicable at the time.
4. Fifty years after the date of the gift, not only the income but the principal as well may be expended in whole or in part by those then responsible for its use, either for the specific purpose for which the gift was originally made or for any other specific purpose which in their judgment will best promote the original general purpose of the gift, with the provision, however, that such other specific purpose shall be as closely akin to the original purpose as may be found practicable at the time.

THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that The Rockefeller Foundation inform the recipients of grants of endowment funds made prior to the adoption of the above statement of policy that as far as The Rockefeller Foundation is concerned such endowment funds may be utilized in the manner described in the said statement.
