Memorandum to Mr. H. A. Garside regarding the funds from the Estate of Lucy K. Sacks

The section of the Last Will and Testament relative to Peking University, reads:

"To Peking University where I. T. Headland taught (\$1000.00) One thousand dollars Methodist College in China."

Regarding the terms and conditions of the "D. Willis James Foundation" I attach Dr. North's letter to Dr. Barton under date of June 9, 1925 covering the agreement which was finally signed. The original, of which the form of agreement attached is a carbon, was duly signed and returned to us, and is now in the safe. I am also attaching Dr. Barton's letter of July 1, 1925, as I think this is briefer than attempting to summarize the situation.
