

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## Notes on the Making of the Cost-of-living Index Numbers for the Working Classes in Peking

The study in the cost of living in Peking has been undertaken by several individuals.<sup>1</sup> They have made inquiries into the family or the individual expenditure of the working classes in Peking in order to find the way in which they are living and how changes in the cost of living have affected them. These studies, however, all ended with the discovery and analysis of the existing facts and none has attempted to supply continuous information about the fluctuation of such costs and their effect on the livelihood of the people. An exception, however, was the work of the Institute of Social Sciences 社會科學研究所.<sup>2</sup> From January, 1929, to July, 1937, the date of the outbreak of the hostilities between Japan and China, it published monthly the index numbers of the cost of living for the working classes in Peking, the numbers being calculated back to 1926.<sup>3</sup> The suspension of this valuable work is a loss not only to the students of social sciences but also to all who are interested in such problems. Realizing this, the Department of Economics of Yenching University undertook to continue the compilation of such figures.

Since the present index is a continuation of that of the Institute of Social Sciences, there is in general no change as to either the scope or methods of construction. The chief differences are a shift in the base year from 1927 to 1936 and an addition of 15 vegetable stands to the 42 shops already used as sources of price data.

The scope and methods of making this index have been explained in great detail by Mr. Simon Yang of the Institute in his booklet, *An Index of the Cost of Living in Peiping*.<sup>4</sup> In view of the removal of the Institute from Peiping to Nanking and from Nanking to the interior of the country in 1937 and since that booklet may be out of print, a brief summary of its content, together with modifications made in the present index, is deemed necessary here.

*Assortment of Commodities and Weights* The following commodities and weights are used in the making of the index:

Since the outbreak of hostilities, Peking has been faced with a shortage of supplies. We have, therefore, occasionally been compelled to use substitutes for several articles, especially those in the category of clothing materials. Due care has been given to the selection of these substitutes, and they have been abandoned whenever the original articles became available.

*Price data* Data on retail prices of the above mentioned commodities are collected by our field investigators on the second and the sixteenth of each month from 42 shops and 15 vegetable stands in nine sections of Peking. The shops deal in grain, vegetables, oil and condiments, beef and mutton, pork, cloth, coal and groceries, and are distributed as follows:

*Formula* The formula used is the aggregative, weighted by quantities of annual consumption of a family of 3.38 equivalent adults obtained through the family budget study made by the Institute during the period from November, 1926, to April, 1927.<sup>5</sup> It is formula 53, enumerated in Fisher's *The Making of Index Numbers*. In computing the index, no "group weights" are assigned to the five categories of articles as listed above because the assortments of the commodities are made according to their relative importance.

*Base period* The average prices of 1927 were used by the Institute as the basis for the index calculation. The present index, however, adopts 1936 as the base year. The reasons for such a change are: First, the old base year is so remote in time that it renders impressions vague and indefinite. Secondly, 1936 was a comparatively normal year as viewed from the economic, social and political angles. The average indices of 1936 as shown by the Institute's index are as follows: food, 99.5; clothing, 97.1; housing, 108.2; fuel and light, 98.6; miscellaneous, 113.2; and the total cost of living, 100.2. Thirdly, this year was also the last complete calendar year immediately preceding the

present hostilities; hence the adoption of 1936 as a base provides a better basis for comparison of the cost of living during and after the conflict with that before it. Furthermore, the use of the aggregative formula enables us to shift the base by the short method, i.e., by dividing the indices by the index of the new base and multiplying each result by 100, and does not involve error.

The present work was started in July of 1939, two years after the month in which the Institute of Social Sciences suspended its work. Because of the political and economic uncertainty which prevailed during this interval, the work of collecting price data for the back months were extremely difficult. Investigators, consisting of both the regular staff members and the students of the Department, were sent to the field to make contacts with the retailers in the city. The work would have to have been given up had not these dealers so kindly placed at our disposal their old accounts from which price quotations of the past months were taken. Accounts from at least four retailers, and in many cases as many as ten, were obtained for these months. Records kept by the students' dining halls and by the Practice House of the Home Economics Department at Yenching were used as a check on accuracy. With these facilities, the Department has been able to calculate the numbers back to July, 1937. For the period after July, 1939, the work has proceeded smoothly according to the process described above.

Index numbers for the years from 1926 to 1939 and those for the months from January of 1937 to December of 1939 are at present available and are given in the following table. The figures for the period before July, 1937, have been converted from the indices published by the Institute of Social Sciences. These figures together with those for the later months are self explanatory.<sup>6</sup> The rising trends of the costs, the greatest characteristic of their movement during the last three years, are more clearly indicated in the chart on the cover of the present issue of the publication.

Two points, however, require explanation here. In the first place, indices on prices in terms of coppers are not given in the present index numbers as they were in those of the Institute. This is due to the fact that since the outbreak of hostilities prices have soared so drastically that they are not measurable in terms of coppers as fractions of a cent and copper prices are no longer quoted in the market. In the second place, the application of price control measures have long been proclaimed in this city but have been strictly enforced only since last October. As a result, prices of many commodities have been curtailed but these restrictions have greatly encouraged adulteration and produced deterioration in the quality of the goods. The consuming populace has had to sacrifice quality for lower prices. These price control measures have thus introduced factors which have complicated the index making. On the one hand, the official prices are the only available quotations in the market. Should these prices be used for the calculation, no account is taken for the change in quality. If, on the other hand, it is desired to make allowance for this, prices equivalent to those of the original qualities of the articles have to be calculated by mathematical interpolation. In view of this complication, two numbers have been given for the costs of food and fuel and for the general index since October of last year. The numbers in ordinary type are based on prices fixed by the municipal government, while those given in parentheses for the corresponding commodities are based on the calculated prices. Users of this index, therefore, have entire freedom in the choice between the two widely differing sets of indices.



## Notes on the Making of the Index Numbers for the Foreign Exchange Rates in Tientsin

The fluctuations of the value of the currency in North China have been closely watched by economists and businessmen since the outbreak of hostilities in 1937, because the change in the value of money is usually taken as an indication of economic conditions. The value of a currency is generally expressed by two phenomena: one being the general price level of the area where the currency is used and the other being its foreign exchange rates. The former reveals its value at home, while the latter indicates its value relative to foreign currencies. It is for the purpose of measuring the external value of the currency in North China that the Department of Economics of Yenching University has compiled the monthly index numbers of the foreign exchange rates in Tientsin.<sup>1</sup>

The currency in North China has given rise to many complicated problems since the establishment of the Federal Reserve Bank and the ban on the Chinese National Currency in March, 1938. Though the use of the C. N. C. is officially forbidden, it is commonly known that it still circulates side by side with the local currency, i. e., the F. R. B. notes. This is specially true in the Tientsin concessions over which so far the local authorities have had no control. Exchange quotations are still being issued in terms of C. N. C., and banks evaluate local currency on the same basis in exchange transactions. These factors complicate the index making. In view of these complications, two series of index numbers are compiled—one denoting the movements of the rates as they are quoted in C. N. C., the other denoting their fluctuations in terms of the local currency. The rates in the local currency are obtained by multiplying the C. N. C. quotations by the average monthly ratio between the two currencies. These two series of index numbers are hereafter referred to as the C. N. C. index numbers and the I. c. index numbers.

In connection with the making of these index numbers, four points need explanation: namely, the data, the base, the weighting and the formula.

**Data** The exchange rates included in these index numbers are the monthly averages of the daily T. T. selling rates for direct exchange on London, New York, Paris, and Tokyo, issued by the Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation in Tientsin. These rates are originally quoted in terms of their own respective currencies, and are not usable for the construction of the indices because they are not expressed in a common unit of measurement. It is the reciprocals of these original quotations that are used, for these express the amount of the native currency in terms of a unit of the respective foreign currencies.

The rate on Tokyo has been omitted since March, 1938. This is due to two facts. First, since that month the exchange rate between the Japanese *yen* and the local *yuan* has been arbitrarily fixed at par with no regard to the international aspect of the problem. It is commonly believed, however, that exchange of Japanese currency has been carried on to

some extent in the Black Bourse at higher rates. For these rates, however, we lack information. Secondly, since 1938 a barter system for the exchange of goods between Japan and North China has been set up, so a very large portion of trading does not require money transaction although the balance of this trade<sup>2</sup> may be paid in cash. If this trade surplus is taken into account with the rate of exchange at par, our total index numbers for the last two years would be smaller than they are presented here. That is to say, the currency in North China would worth more than is indicated by our general index numbers.

**Base** The base periods for our index numbers differ for the two series. The C. N. C. indices adopt the average of 1936 as base. This year is chosen as a base chiefly because it makes possible a better comparison of the exchange rates after the outbreak of hostilities with those before it. For the I. c. index numbers, the average of March, 1938, is used, because this currency has been in circulation only since that time. Because of the different base periods, the two series of indices show only the tendencies of the fluctuations of the foreign exchange rates expressed in terms of each currency and, therefore, the differences between them do not measure their relative value.

**Weighting** The weight used for each month is the value of the direct foreign trade between China and the respective countries whose exchange rates are used in the compilation of the indices for the year ending three months prior to the month at issue. If weighting is to be considered, a shifting weighting will certainly give a more accurate result than a fixed weighting, for it makes possible a more sensitive adjustment to the changes created by the frequent variations in the value of trade with the different countries.<sup>3</sup> The disadvantage of using only the direct trade value as a weight is that it does not take into consideration the invisible returns in the nation's foreign trade. These, however, have to be omitted on account of lack of adequate data.

**Formula** The formula for the construction of these index numbers is the weighted aggregative. Expressed algebraically, it is:

$T_i$  represents the value of trade with each country in Chinese National Currency as

recorded by the Chinese Maritime Customs.  $R_i$  represents the equivalent of Chinese dollar to the respective foreign currencies as published by the same organization. Therefore,  $\frac{T_i}{R_i}$ , as weight, is the value of trade with each country in terms of the respective foreign currencies.  $R_i$  represents the current rate of exchange of each month, while  $R_0$  represents the average rate of exchange of the base period.

The index numbers published herewith are, therefore, compiled by these methods and are confined within the scope indicated above. The C. N. C. indices begin from January, 1937,<sup>4</sup> while the l. c. numbers begin from March, 1938. They are presented both in the following table and in the chart on the front page of this issue.

#### THE MONTHLY INDEX NUMBERS OF THE COST OF LIVING IN PEKING

A new series of indices is added to this index number in this issue. They express the purchasing power of the money in the retail market, the average of 1936 being taken as 100. For example, the figure for January, 1940, is 34.3, that is to say, a dollar which was worth one dollar in 1936 was worth only 34.3 cents in January, 1940. Readers, however, should pay attention to the change in the currency system of North China in March, 1938. Since that month, the F. R. B. notes have gradually been substituted for the old notes. Therefore, these figures denote the purchasing power of two different kinds of currencies; those for the months before March, 1938, denoting the purchasing power of the old notes and those after that date denoting that of the F. R. B. notes.

The price control measure mentioned in the last issue has been partly suspended in Peking. On January 16th, the local authorities announced that the official prices of flour and grains were temporarily off. This suspension did not take effect immediately, so the quotations that our investigators collected on the 16th of the month, the day on which the local authorities made the announcement, were still those of the official fixed prices.

### NOTES

THE PEKING COST-OF-LIVING INDEX rose to 393.6 in February, an increase of 137.9 points over the previous month. All the five components advanced, but the greatest rise was in food. The index for this group of articles was 431.2 as compared with 260.8 for January. Although the rising trend has been characteristic of the cost of living of this city since 1937, a radical advance such as this is unprecedented.

The same tendency toward increase is evident in THE INDEX OF FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATES IN TIENTSIN. The C. N. C. index for February was 415.12, as compared with 340.89 for the previous month and 454.74 for August, 1938, the peak of the last three years. Of the three currencies, the U. S. dollar gained 86.80 points over January, the sterling gained 66.11 points and the franc, 31.72 points. On account of the difficulty in obtaining information, we are unable to publish the February indices for l. c. in this number of the publication.

In the appendix of this issue, the Monthly Index Numbers of Commodity Prices at Wholesale in North China are added. These indices are compiled by the Japanese-sponsored *China Problems Research Institute*. The original base year of 1926, however, was converted to 1936 in our compilation.

### NOTES

A further increase has carried THE PEKING COST-OF-LIVING INDEX to its highest point since 1937. The index for March was 461.2, being an increase of 67.6 points over the previous month. Indices of the five components all showed rise, led by food which was followed by: miscellaneous goods, clothing materials, rent, and fuel and light.

A similar tendency toward increase was indicated by all but one of the C. N. C. indices of the foreign exchange rates in Tientsin. The increases were in the U. S. dollar and the franc while the sterling met a slight drop of 1.52 points from February. These changes sent THE INDEX OF THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATES IN TIENTSIN up to 428.24 in March. The February index for l. c. also showed an increase but it was greater than that for C. N. C.

Beginning with this issue, the retail prices of the articles included in the cost-of-living index numbers and the exchange rates included in the exchange-rate index numbers are published together with the indices. Moreover, for the purpose of comparison with our Peking index, the Monthly Index Numbers of the Cost of Living for the Working Classes in Tientsin are added in the appendix of this issue. It will be published in every other issue alternately with the wholesale-price index numbers.

### NOTES

For the first time in this year, THE PEKING COST OF-LIVING INDEX has shown a downward movement. Of the five components, two declined and three were up in April. The sharpest drop was that for food. That for miscellaneous items also showed a similar tendency, though the decrease was not as great as the former one. Those indicating an upward trend were fuel and light, clothing materials and house rent. Since a greater weight is assigned to food items, the decrease of their prices, together with those of the miscellaneous goods, was more than enough to offset the increase brought by other articles. As a result, the index of the total cost of living for April declined from 461.2 of March to 444.8.

THE INDEX OF THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATES IN TIENTSIN, however, still kept on rising. The C. N. C. general index for the three currencies was 445.05 for April, as compared with 428.24 for the previous month. The rise was solely caused by the increase in the value of the U. S. dollar. Its index was 538.39, a gain of 28.96 points over the previous month, thus reaching a new peak for the last three years. This exceeded the earlier maximum of September, 1939, when the level was at 518.82. The total increase in the general index was slightly retarded by the reverse movements of the sterling and the franc.

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**NOTES**

THE PEKING COST-OF-LIVING INDEX, which had shown signs of recession in April, turned upward to a new level in May. The figure reached 475.4 from 444.8 for the previous month. This compares with 461.2 for March. The cause of the advance is due to the increase in the prices of clothing and food articles. The advance in the former group is abnormal, being a sudden gain of about 100 points over the previous month. The prices of the remaining groups have, however, decreased slightly.

In view of the fact that the term "silver dollar prices" may cause unnecessary confusion to our readers, it has been changed into "dollar prices." We hope it is plain that this term is used here in distinction from the "copper prices" which have been used by many of the cost-of-living index numbers for this country and are still being used by some.

Because of the decline in the value of the Chinese currency, THE INDEX OF THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATES IN TIENTSIN rose radically in May. All the three components of the index advanced. The increase was led by the U. S. dollar which was followed by the sterling and the French franc. These advances sent the index up to 644.22, a peak unprecedented not only in the last three years, the period covered by our index numbers, but also in the monetary history of China.

THE INDEX OF THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATES IN TIENTSIN which reached an unprecedented level in May decreased by 64.54 points in the following month, i. e., 579.68 for June as compared with 644.22 for the previous month. The currencies that faced decline in their value were the U. S. dollar and the sterling, the former registering a drop of 39.26 points and the latter a drop of 10.38 points. The French franc, however, gained by 6.99 points.

### NOTES

Continuing the downward movement of the previous two months, THE PEKING COST-OF-LIVING INDEX declined to 404.0 for July. This was a decrease of 67.6 points from June and a decrease of 71.4 points from May, the peak month of the period covered by our index numbers. Three of the five components were responsible for the drop, namely, food, clothing materials, and fuel and light.

This month there was a shortage of certain brands of goods that have been used for the index-making. Their prices, therefore, were made up by the following processes. First, substitutes were carefully chosen. Secondly, a ratio between the prices of the original brand and its substitute for June was secured for each article. And lastly, approximate prices for July of the original articles were obtained according to these ratios. Five articles in the group of clothing materials and one in that of miscellaneous goods were thus interpolated.

Since the beginning of the European War, transactions of the French franc in Tientsin have been decreasing in amount. By July, they had become so inconsiderable that the rate was nominal. As a result, THE INDEX OF THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATES IN TIENTSIN for this month was the average of only the sterling and the U. S. dollar. Both of these currencies faced a further drop in their values. These changes thus brought the general index down to 530.61 from the level of 579.68 for June.

ERRATA—On p. 39 in the last issue, the price of eggplant for June, 1940, should be \$0.0617 instead of \$0.2617 and that of raw cotton for the same month should be \$1.7340 instead of \$1.7320.

### NOTES

A further decrease of 11.3 points from July was registered by THE PEKING COST-OF-LIVING INDEX for August. Although this decline was only slight as compared with that of the previous month, the downward movement of the price level seems to have definitely set in. All the five components except rent dropped in their prices. Rent in this city has recently risen at an abnormal rate. Up to the end of the last month covered by our study, this rising tendency was still continuing.

There was still no market for the French franc in August in Tientsin, but the rates for the remaining two components of THE INDEX OF THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATES IN TIENSIN which showed signs of recession in the previous month picked up considerably. This brought the general index up to 569.84, a gain of 39.23 points over July.

Beginning with this issue, a revision has been made in the general index for the l.c. The revision was effected by using a shifting weighting in the calculation of the indices. This change, thus, makes possible a comparison of the movements of the C.N.C. and the l.c. index numbers.

### NOTES

Up to the end of September the downward movement of THE PEKING COST-OF-LIVING INDEX was still continuing. The general index was 383.6 as compared with 392.7 for the previous month and with 475.4 for May of this year, the peak month of the past years. This decline brought the cost of living in Peking back to a level near to that of February of this year, the latter being 10 points above the former. Of the five components, three declined and two gained as compared with August. The largest decline was that in food while clothing materials and fuel and light made only slight drop. These decreases were more than enough to offset the increases brought by other commodities.

The average exchange rate of the Chinese currency met with a further loss as THE INDEX OF THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATE IN TIENTSIN for September showed an increase of 19 points over August. Since May of this year, a mathematical error has been made in the process of calculating the general indices. The figures published in this issue are the corrected ones. According to these figures, it was in September instead of in May, as announced by us in the June issue, that the highest level of the exchange rate was set. The numbers for May, August and September are 539.51, 532.84 and 551.85 respectively. The gain by the U.S. dollar of 21.63 points over the previous month is chiefly responsible for the increase of the index for last month.

### NOTES

After several months of recession, the movement of THE PEKING COST-OF-LIVING INDEX came to a standstill in October. The general index for that month was 382.9 while that for September was 383.6, the difference between the two being 0.7 points which is inconsiderable. The indices of the five components changed in different directions. Food, the main item, showed a decline of 3.4 points from the previous month. Miscellaneous goods and fuel and light were the two other groups of goods which decreased in price. Clothing materials made the sharpest change of all the components. Its index advanced from 436.7 for September to 460.7 while rent gained by 4.6 points.

THE INDEX OF THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATE IN TIENTSIN dropped considerably in October. It was 505.40 as compared with 551.85 for the previous month. This means that in the month of October the average value of the C. N. C. in term of foreign currencies has picked up by 9.27% over the previous month. The index numbers of the two component currencies were as follows: the U. S. dollar, 541.22 for October and 597.26 for September, and the sterling, 405.05 for October and 428.78 for September.

# INDEX NUMBERS

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## NOTES

THE PEKING COST-OF-LIVING INDEX resumed its upward trend in the month of November, with increases recorded in three of its five components. The number moved to 388.4 from 382.9, a gain of 5.5 points. The increases were in food, clothing materials and house rent, the indexes for them being as follows: food, 385.1 for October and 390.2 for November; clothing, 460.7 for October and 478.9 for November; and housing, 471.5 for October and 496.1 for November. The decreases in fuel and light and miscellaneous goods are not so remarkable as the gains, their numbers being 292.8 and 248.4 for October and 288.6 and 239.6 for November respectively.

The continuous drop of THE INDEX OF THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATE IN TIENTSIN in November indicated a further appreciation in the value of the C. N. C. in term of foreign currencies. The November figure was 46.3 points smaller than that of the previous month. Of the two foreign currencies, the U. S. dollar dropped by 52.63 points while the sterling dropped by 36.01 points. These changes brought the general index down to 458.1 from 505.4.
